Cancellations: Streetsboro Senior Center & Parks & Recreation Departments reserves the right to cancel any class or program that does not meet the minimum required participants. If your class is cancelled, we will notify you by phone, text or email. You may transfer to another class or program, receive a credit for a later class or program, or receive a refund. Program dates and times are subject to change on short notice.

Refund Policy: Refunds will be granted if request is made within 5 working days after the program deadline. A \$5 administrative fee will be withheld. Refunds will not be granted once a program begins. Acceptable exceptions are an injury that prohibits participant's involvement or a doctor's statement of participant's inability to participate. Please allow 3-4 weeks for refund by mail. Refunds or credits will be given for classes cancelled by the departments.

Programs cancelled by the Streetsboro Senior Center you will receive a full refund of program fees. If you must cancel for any reason including illness, please give at least 7 days notice prior to the program date. Refunds will be given only if no expenses/ticket purchases have occurred. Approved refunds will be applied as a program credit for future programs. If a refund check is requested, there will be a \$5 processing fee. Any cancellations within 7 days of the program will not receive a credit or refund. You are welcome to have someone take your place.





Gift Delivery Instructions

Please have your child (accompanied by an adult) waiting at the end of your driveway on your delivery day. Santa cannot wait.

In case of Severe Weather...We will make every effort to deliver gifts on Saturday, December 14, but in the case of severe weather it may be necessary to delay, postpone, or cancel delivery. In this case:

- The Department will send TEXT MESSAGES notifying participants of the cancelation (If we do not have an updated contact number on file then you will NOT receive the message, so please update your contact info.).








Senior Spotlight

The Streetsboro Community Center offers a versatile hall perfect for a range of gatherings, including wedding receptions, Bar/Bat Mitzvahs, festive parties, business meetings, charity events, class reunions, baby showers, birthday celebrations, and much more. The primary hall is sized at 63 by 33 feet, fitting around 180 people, or seating about 110 guests, depending on the setup. This space can be divided into a smaller section (42 x 33 feet), accommodating approximately 120 guests or seating about 80.

Each booking requires at least a three-hour rental time.

This time should include setup and cleanup. You can add extra hours for setup and clean-up if needed (see pricing for hourly rates).

When you rent, you get up to 150 chairs, (15) 6-foot round tables, (10) 4-foot round tables, or (10) 6-foot rectangular tables.

Streetsboro residents can book up to a year in advance with at least two weeks' notice. Non-residents can reserve up to six months in advance.

Booking isn't confirmed until you pay a security deposit and sign the Rental Agreement. Deposits can be made by cash or check. It's important to note that reservations must be made in person.

PAVILION RENTAL INFORMATION

Any person or organization wanting to reserve the pavilion at City Park shall obtain a permit from the Parks & Recreation Department. The fee for the use of the pavilion by a Streetsboro resident, business or organization located within the City is \$45 per rental, up to one day. The fee for the use of the pavilion by a non-resident, business or organization not located within the City is \$65 per rental, up to one day.

North Pavilion Size 32 x 48: 12 picnic tables approx. seating for 72 people. South Pavilion Size: 31 x 31: 10 picnic tables approx. seating for 60 people.

Please follow the guidelines listed below when confirming a rental:

- All rental fees are due at the time of the reservation
- Rentals will be granted on a first come, first serve basis
- Residents of Streetsboro may make pavilion rentals up to 1 year in advance
- Non-residents may make pavilion rentals 6 months in advance
- A \$25 additional cleaning fee may be assessed if the facility is not found in a clean condition


Pets
