

I would like to replace our current hydraulic extrication equipment ("the jaws") with battery powered equipment. Our current set is more than 15 years old and does not have the ability to cut through some new model vehicles steel framing. Another advantage is we are no longer limited to the length of the hydraulic hoses, which gives us a greater operational range with the tools. We brought in junk cars during the month of June and drilled cutting up these vehicles with all three manufacturers of these tools (Atlantic, Heritage and Genesis). After reviewing their performance, we would like to Purchase the Genesis tools for \$50,735.00. Attached are three quotes from the above-mentioned manufacturers. The purchase was planned in our ten-year capital replacement program and is available in line item 402.12.5745.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HOWELL RESCUE SYSTEMS FOR A BATTERY-OPERATED GENESIS RESCUE SYSTEM TO REPLACE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S CURRENT HYDRAULIC RESCUE SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXPEDITE THE PURCHASE OF THE NEW RESCUE SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Streetsboro Fire Department currently uses a hydraulic extrication system known as "The Jaws of Life" to rescue persons trapped in a vehicle following an accident; and

WHEREAS, the system is 15-years old and does not have the ability to cut through the framing of some modern vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the length of the hydraulic hoses of the current system limit its operational range; and

WHEREAS, a battery-operated system would solve these problems and accordingly, the Fire Department obtained three quotes on new equipment; and

WHEREAS, after testing the new systems using junk vehicles, the Fire Department selected Howell Rescue Systems and the battery-operated Genesis Rescue System at a cost of \$50,735.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Streetsboro, Portage County, Ohio, thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an Agreement with Howell Rescue Systems for a battery-operated Genesis Rescue System for a cost not to exceed \$50,735.00.

SECTION 2: The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for the same from Account No. 402.12.5745.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

SECTION 4: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the residents of this City for the reason that it is immediately necessary to enable the Fire Department to obtain and use modern battery-operated rescue equipment, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

I would request this item be placed on the August 12, 2024, Safety Committee for discussion and the August 12, 2024, Full Council for consideration of approval under emergency legislation.

In early 2024, I applied for a grant through the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services (OCJS). The submission was for participation in a Pilot Program for the dissemination of an in-canal hearing protection product with a minimum noise reduction rating of 25 decibels and a maximum output of 80 decibels. The hearing protection baffles loud noises and still allows the user to hear sounds at a conversational level.

The grant covered the hearing protection for each sworn member of the Streetsboro Police Department. At the time of the grant, there was no specific model to look up and/or pricing. We have since received the hearing protection and found them to be the SOUNDGEAR instant fit high-definition hearing protection & sound enhancement with a 25db noise reduction rating. Searching the equipment, we found a retail price of \$400 each. The grant covered 30 of them for the department at a value of \$12,000. An unexpected secondary shipment of 3600 1.45v batteries also arrived with an estimated value of \$1020.

The SOUNDGEAR hearing protection will be a great asset when working events like Family Days where the music is extremely loud, but officers still need to be able to hear conversations and the activity around them or at the range when the repetitive gun fire can cause damage, but the officers still need to be able to hear the range master.

I would ask that Council approve the acceptance of the OCJS grant supplied equipment.

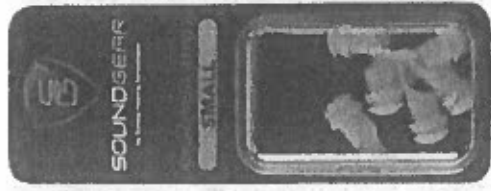

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT 30 UNITS OF SOUNDGEAR HEARING PROTECTION EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE STREETSBORO POLICE, TO BE FUNDED BY A GRANT FROM THE OHIO OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY SO THAT THE HEARING PROTECTION EQUIPMENT MAY BE USED IMMEDIATELY.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police previously applied for a grant from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services ("OCJS") to participate in a Pilot Program for the dissemination of an in-canal hearing protection product to protect hearing against loud noises but still allows the user to hear sounds at a conversational level; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department subsequently received 30 units of Soundgear instant fit high-definition hearing protection and sound enhancement equipment valued at \$12,000, along with 3,600 1.45v batteries with a estimated value of \$1,020, which are covered by the OJCS grant; and

WHEREAS, the hearing protection will be an asset to the Police Department, allowing officers at events like Family Days, to hear conversations and action around them despite loud music and to hear range masters despite loud gunfire at the range;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Streetsboro, Portage County, Ohio, thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is authorized to accept Soundgear Hearing Protection Equipment for use by the Police Department covered by a grant through a Pilot Program with the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services.

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the residents of this City for the reason that the Police Department wishes to immediately use the Soundgear Hearing Protection Equipment and provided it receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
