

Cancellations: Streetsboro Senior Center & Parks & Recreation Departments reserves the right to cancel any class or program that does not meet the minimum required participants. If your class is cancelled, we will notify you by phone, text or email. You may transfer to another class or program, receive a credit for a later class or program, or receive a refund. Program dates and times are subject to change on short notice.

Refund Policy: Refunds will be granted if request is made within 5 working days after the program deadline. A \$5 administrative fee will be withheld. Refunds will not be granted once a program begins. Acceptable exceptions are an injury that prohibits participant's involvement or a doctor's statement of participant's inability to participate. Please allow 3-4 weeks for refund by mail. Refunds or credits will be given for classes cancelled by the departments.

Programs cancelled by the Streetsboro Senior Center you will receive a full refund of program fees. If you must cancel for any reason including illness, please give at least 7 days notice prior to the program date. Refunds will be given only if no expenses/ticket purchases have occurred. Approved refunds will be applied as a program credit for future programs. If a refund check is requested, there will be a \$5 processing fee. Any cancellations within 7 days of the program will not receive a credit or refund. You are welcome to have someone take your place.

Deadline Policy/Fee: If a program is registered for after the noted deadline, the departments reserves the right to add a fee. If there are not enough participants registered by the noted program deadline, the departments reserves the right to cancel the program.

Errors and Mistakes: Although our staff works hard to ensure each program guide is free from mistakes, there are moments when errors in dates, times, rates or registration information occurs. We will do everything possible to make corrections, and we thank you for your understanding when these situations arise.





Splash Pad Hours: Daily from 11:00 AM - 7:00 PM (weather permitting)
Splash Pad Season: End of May - Mid September (weather permitting)

- NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY: Play at your own risk.
- In the event of thunder or lightning, vacate the area and seek shelter.
- Children must be supervised at all times.
- · No food, drink, glass, animals, or personal toys allowed.
- Children and individuals in diapers must wear swim diapers.
- · Wash hands after using the restroom, or changing diapers.
- · Change diapers only in the restroom.





Friends of Pierce - Streetsboro Library



The Streetsboro Community Center offers a versatile hall perfect for a range of gatherings, including wedding receptions, Bar/Bat Mitzvahs, festive parties, business meetings, charity events, class reunions, baby showers, birthday celebrations, and much more. The primary hall is sized at 63 by 33 feet, fitting around 180 people, or seating about 110 guests, depending on the setup. This space can be divided into a smaller section (42 x 33 feet), accommodating approximately 120 guests or seating about 80.

Each booking requires at least a three-hour rental time.

This time should include setup and cleanup. You can add extra hours for setup and clean-up if needed (see pricing for hourly rates).

When you rent, you get up to 150 chairs, (15) 6-foot round tables, (10) 4-foot round tables, or (10) 6-foot rectangular tables.

WILCOX MEMORIAL PARK, 825 ST. RT. 303

Wilcox Memorial Park is located north of ST. RT. 303 and west of Route 43. The park consists of playgrounds for children ages 2-5 and 5-12. Parents and guardians can relax on benches while their children play! PAVILION RENTAL INFORMATION

Any person or organization wanting to reserve the pavilion at City Park shall obtain a permit from the Parks & Recreation Department. The fee for the use of the pavilion by a Streetsboro resident, business or organization located within the City is \$45 per rental, up to one day. The fee for the use of the pavilion by a non-resident, business or organization not located within the City is \$65 per rental, up to one day.

North Pavilion Size 32 x 48: 12 picnic tables approx, seating for 70 people. South Pavilion Size: 31 x 31: 10 picnic tables approx. seating for 60 people. Floyd North Pavilion Size 24 x 44: 12 picnic tables approx. seating 70 people.

Please follow the guidelines listed below when confirming a rental:

- All rental fees are due at the time of the reservation
- Rentals will be granted on a first come, first serve basis Residents of Streetsboro may make pavilion rentals up to 6 months in advance
- Non-residents may make pavilion rentals 3 months in advance
- A \$25 additional cleaning fee may be assessed if the facility is not found in a clean condition All rentals are from 9:00 AM Dusk.

Pets: All pets must be on a leash at all times when on City property (with exception of the Dog Park). Pets and owners may be asked to leave and not return at the discretion of the Parks & Recreation staff at any time.

Smoking Policy: Fans/spectators are reminded that there is no smoking permitted within 100' of any City-owned playing field or event. (C.O.S. 2014-108)
