### Authorize Expenditures for Backflow Surveys, Inspections, Reporting

Bill Miller said this would keep the Water Department EPA compliant. It would cost up to \$15,436.40 from GL 501-52-5733. Bill Miller said the company had done a quick survey while they were doing meters and they had missed some and the City did get credited for them. They would start with those meters with this survey and at the end of the day when this program gets fully involved it would be pretty much little to no cost to the City because people each year would be charged for their backflow. Over a five year period it pretty much covers the whole amount of money. The City would need to put the money out up front and then slowly get reimbursed. Next

year, once the Department had determined if they liked the program, they would bring the agreement to City Council to approve a five-year contract.
