T-6927 Amend Ord. No. 2020-141 Fire Prevention Vehicle

Chief Reinholz said Council had passed an Ordinance at the last Council meeting, but he had forgotten to include the trade in value for the Ford Focus in the legislation that would be traded in

with Lebanon Ford. It was calculated into the total price of the new fire prevention vehicle but it had not been included in the legislation.

T-6928 Purchase Turnout Gear for FD

Chief Reinholz said the turnout gear was the bunker pants, bunker coat and suspenders, but it only had a usable life of 10 years per NFPA standards, so the Fire Department planned to purchase a few sets of turnout gear every year so all 43 sets were replaced over a 9-10 year period. This purchase of 10 sets of turnout gear was planned in the 2020 budget. Chief Reinholz had received two comparable quotes and suggested buying from Fire Force because the department already had turnout gear from them and wanted to go with the same kind again.

T-6929 Accept Donation from Crimes Against Children Task Force

Chief Wain asked Council to accept a financial donation of \$3385.00 to be used to purchase a DataPilot10. She said Sgt. Siedlecki had cultivated a very strong working relationship with (ICAC) Internet Crimes Against Children in his work in getting predators off the street. This DataPilot10 was software and equipment that would help the department do forensic examinations of laptops and cell phones to get further evidence of those crimes.
