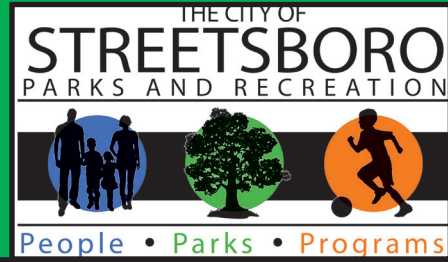

Registration Reminder: SPRD can not take payment over the phone or hold a registration space without payment. Registration is available online at www.cityofstreetsboro.com, in person or by mail.

In Person: SPRD office is located at 9307 State Route 43, Streetsboro.

By Mail: Completed registration forms can be mailed with full payment, check or money order, to 9184 State Route 43, Streetsboro, OH 44241. Make checks payable to: The City of Streetsboro.

Online: You can register online at www.cityofstreetsboro.com (for select programs). An additional \$1 convenience fee will be added.

Drop Box: SPRD offers a drop box outside the office door that is available anytime the building is open. All program payments and registrations can be dropped off if the staff is not available.

Cancellations: SPRD reserves the right to cancel any class or program that does not meet the minimum required participants. If your class is cancelled, we will notify you by phone. You may transfer to another class or program, receive a credit for a later class or program, or receive a refund. Program dates and times are subject to change on short notice.

Refund Policy: Refunds will be granted if request is made 5 working days in advance of the first program date. A \$5 administrative fee will be withheld. Refunds will not be granted once a program begins. Acceptable exceptions are an injury that prohibits participant's involvement or a doctor's statement of participant's inability to participate. Please allow 3-4 weeks for refund by mail. Refunds or credits will be given for classes cancelled by SPRD.

Deadline Policy/Fee: If a program is registered for after the noted deadline, SPRD reserves the right to add a fee. If there are not enough participants registered by the noted program deadline, SPRD reserves the right to cancel the program. Please contact SPRD for applicable fee amounts.

Errors and Mistakes: Although our staff works hard to ensure each program guide is free from mistakes, there are moments when errors in dates, times, rates or registration information occurs. We will do everything possible to make corrections, and we thank you for your understanding when these situations arise.

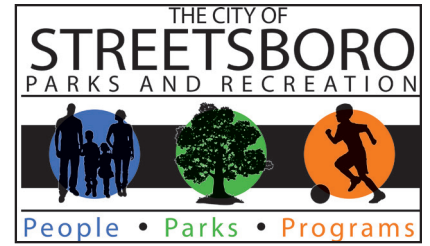

Tree & Bench Dedication Program



The Streetsboro Parks and Recreation Commemorative Tree & Bench Program allows groups and individuals to purchase trees and benches to honor or commemorate friends or loved ones as well as commemorate special events. Trees and benches purchased through the program are planted or placed in a scenic location at one the City's park properties.

Your gift will be a wonderful remembrance or commemoration of a special occasion that adds beauty to the natural environment. It is also a valuable contribution to the City of Streetsboro parks system which is utilized by people of all ages and abilities.

Tree Dedication - \$300

This includes the tree, plaque and continued maintenance of the tree (fertilizing, mulching, pruning, etc.) After the tree is planted, an email will be sent to the donor with a map of the planting location. Trees will be planted during the City's Arbor Day Celebration (held in late April/early May), but they may be ordered at any time and requests received after deadline will be planted the following year.

Bench Dedication - \$1,000

This includes the bench, installation and a commemorative plaque. Benches are installed at approved sites in the order requests are received.

Installation depends on the time of year received and the number of preceding orders. Benches can be requested to be placed at most Streetsboro Parks, until they reach maximum capacity.

Dedication park benches must be placed on solid, flat ground. The price includes the cost of the bench, engraving, freight, installation, and maintenance. Upon receipt, it will take approximately six weeks to complete installation of the park bench. Benches can be installed spring through fall.

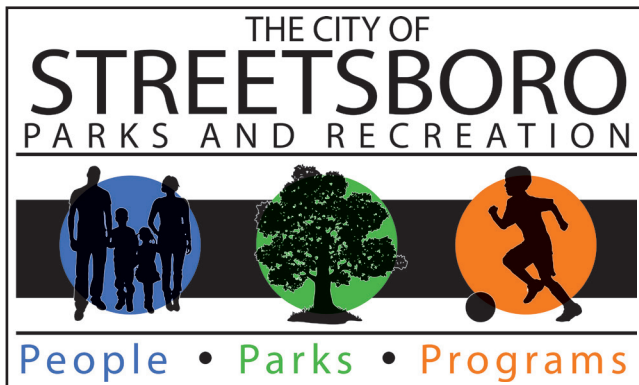

(Deadline to apply and order banner is Monday of the 2nd full week in September.)

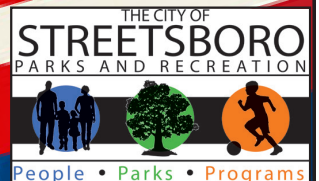

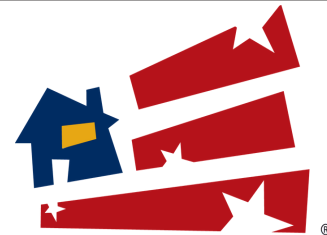

Work on the new Streetsboro Fire Station continues with significant completion expected in early to mid-spring. The fire department expects to move into the new facility over the summer.

The new fire station features 4 pull-through apparatus bays, and 3 back in ambulance bays. Offices, fire gear storage, and other essentials are on the ground floor; with bunk rooms, locker rooms and a workout area located upstairs. The current fire station, part of what was originally Wise Elementary School, will be torn down once vacated.

A public open house will be announced in the near future.



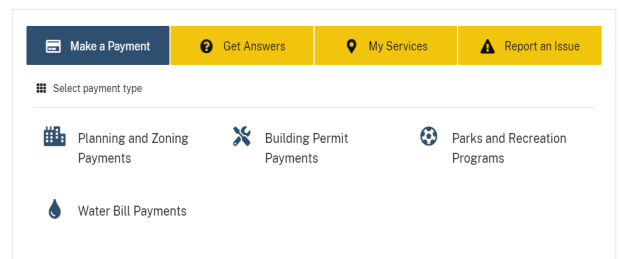

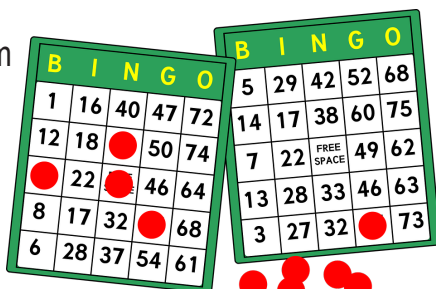

Due to the grant cycle, this program will only be available in 2021-2022, unless the State continues to allocate the resources.

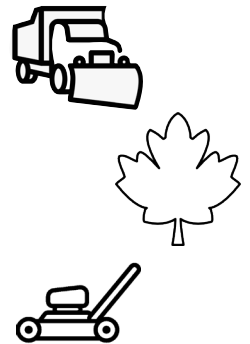

Please visit www.cityofstreetsboro.com and navigate to the Senior Services page to review program offerings, eligibility and program rules.

Eligibility

Eligibility is based on age and/or a documented disability, income, living in a single family owner occupied home and year round residency in the home.

Income eligible applicants will either be:

- Someone at least 65 years of age and be the property owner of record residing at the address on the application.
- Or
- A property owner living with a disability that prevents them from raking leaves, mowing their yard or removing snow.

To be income eligible, the following guidelines apply:

- If you are a one person household, your annual gross income (before taxes) must be at or below \$42,750.
- If you are a two person household, your combined annual gross income (before taxes) must be at or below \$48,850.
- If you are a three person household, your combined annual gross income (before taxes) must be at or below \$54,950.

In addition to documents verifying income, all applicants must provide:

- Proof of age with a current Ohio Driver's License, State of Ohio ID card or Birth Certificate.
- If disabled, a medical certification in the form of a letter from their physician as proof of disability is required.

PAVILION RENTAL INFORMATION

Any person or organization wanting to reserve the pavilion at City Park shall obtain a permit from the Parks & Recreation Department. The fee for the use of the pavilion by a Streetsboro resident, business or organization located within the City is \$30 per rental, up to one day. The fee for the use of the pavilion by a non-resident, business or organization not located within the City is \$50 per rental, up to one day.

Please follow the guidelines listed below when confirming a rental:

- All rental fees are due at the time of the reservation
- Rentals will be granted on a first come, first serve basis
- Residents of Streetsboro may make pavilion rentals up to 1 year in advance
- Non-residents may make pavilion rentals 6 months in advance
- A \$25 additional cleaning fee may be assessed if the facility is not found in a clean condition

Pets

All pets must be on a leash at all times when on City property (with exception of the Dog Park). Pets and owners may be asked to leave and not return at the discretion of the Parks & Recreation staff at any time.

Smoking Policy
