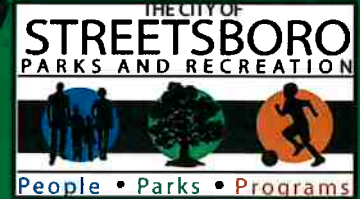

Registration Reminder: SPRD can not take payment over the phone or hold a registration space without payment. Registration is available online at www.cityofstreetsboro.com, in person or by mail.

In Person: SPRD office is located at 9307 State Route 43, Streetsboro.

By Mail: Completed registration forms can be mailed with full payment, check or money order, to 9184 State Route 43, Streetsboro, OH 44241. Make checks payable to: The City of Streetsboro.

Online: You can register online at www.cityofstreetsboro.com (for select programs). An additional \$1 convenience fee will be added.

Drop Box: SPRD offers a drop box outside the office door that is available anytime the building is open. All program payments and registrations can be dropped off if the staff is not available.

Cancellations: SPRD reserves the right to cancel any class or program that does not meet the minimum required participants. If your class is cancelled, we will notify you by phone. You may transfer to another class or program, receive a credit for a later class or program, or receive a refund. Program dates and times are subject to change on short notice.

Refund Policy: Refunds will be granted if request is made 5 working days in advance of the first program date. A \$5 administrative fee will be withheld. Refunds will not be granted once a program begins. Acceptable exceptions are an injury that prohibits participant's involvement or a doctor's statement of participant's inability to participate. Please allow 3-4 weeks for refund by mail. Refunds or credits will be given for classes cancelled by SPRD.

Deadline Policy/Fee: If a program is registered for after the noted deadline, SPRD reserves the right to add a fee. If there are not enough participants registered by the noted program deadline, SPRD reserves the right to cancel the program. Please contact SPRD for applicable fee amounts.

Errors and Mistakes: Although our staff works hard to ensure each program guide is free from mistakes, there are moments when errors in dates, times, rates or registration information occurs. We will do everything possible to make corrections, and we thank you for your understanding when these situations arise.

Streetsboro is proud to continue our business partnership with Nixle- a Community Information Service helping you stay connected to the information that matters to you the most. You can receive trusted, immediate and geographically relevant information by text message, email or over the web. By customizing your free account, you can choose to receive any combination of: Alerts (emergency), Advisories (less urgent need to know information), Community Information (day to day neighborhood info) and Traffic (localized traffic info).

Once you set up an account, you can add additional locations if they have set up an account. For example if you live in Streetsboro but work in Brimfield - you can get alerts for both. Currently there are over 8000 public safety agencies using Nixle and the number continues to increase.

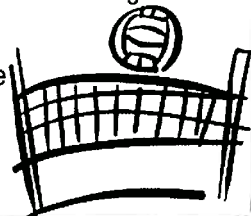

Portage County Senior Assistance Programs

The City is proud to offer a Senior Mowing, Leaf Clean Up, and Snow Plow Assistance Program to assist lower income, full-time residents. The program is designed to assist lower income senior and/or disabled residents take care of their yard and maintain property value. Approved residents will be given vouchers to use at their discretion during the limited 2021-2022 season. Due to the grant cycle, this program will only be available in 2021-2022, unless the State continues to allocate the resources.

Eligibility

Eligibility is based on age and/or a documented disability, income, living in a single family owner occupied home and year round residency in the home.

Income eligible applicants will either be:

- Someone at least 65 years of age and be the property owner of record residing at the address on the application.
Or
- A property owner living with a disability that prevents them from raking leaves, mowing their yard or removing snow.

To be income eligible, the following guidelines apply:

- If you are a one person household, your annual gross income (before taxes) must be at or below \$42,750.
- If you are a two person household, your combined annual gross income (before taxes) must be at or below \$48,850.
- If you are a three person household, your combined annual gross income (before taxes) must be at or below \$54,950.

In addition to documents verifying income, all applicants must provide:

- Proof of age with a current Ohio Driver's License, State of Ohio ID card or Birth Certificate.
- If disabled, a medical certification in the form of a letter from their physician as proof of disability is required.

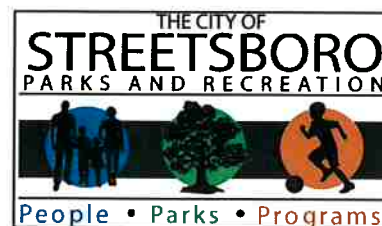

PAVILION RENTAL INFORMATION

Any person or organization wanting to reserve the pavilion at City Park shall obtain a permit from the Parks & Recreation Department. The fee for the use of the pavilion by a Streetsboro resident, business or organization located within the City is \$30 per rental, up to one day. The fee for the use of the pavilion by a non-resident, business or organization not located within the City is \$50 per rental, up to one day.

Please follow the guidelines listed below when confirming a rental:

- All rental fees are due at the time of the reservation
- Rentals will be granted on a first come, first serve basis
- Residents of Streetsboro may make pavilion rentals up to 1 year in advance
- Non-residents may make pavilion rentals 6 months in advance
- A \$25 additional cleaning fee may be assessed if the facility is not found in a clean condition

Pets

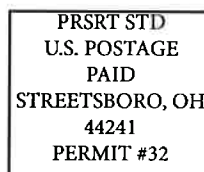
