**Registration Reminder:** SPRD can not take payment over the phone or hold a registration space without payment. Registration is available online at [www.cityofstreetsboro.com](http://www.cityofstreetsboro.com), in person or by mail.

**By Mail:** Completed registration forms can be mailed with full payment, check or money order, to 9184 State Route 43, Streetsboro, OH 44241. Make checks payable to: The City of Streetsboro.

**Online:** You can register online at [www.cityofstreetsboro.com](http://www.cityofstreetsboro.com) (for select programs). An additional \$1 convenience fee will be added.

**Cancellations:** SPRD reserves the right to cancel any class or program that does not meet the minimum required participants. If your class is cancelled, we will notify you by phone. You may transfer to another class or program, receive a credit for a later class or program, or receive a refund. Program dates and times are subject to change on short notice.

**Refund Policy:** Refunds will be granted if request is made 5 working days in advance of the first program date. A \$5 administrative fee will be withheld. Refunds will not be granted once a program begins. Acceptable exceptions are an injury that prohibits participant's involvement or a doctor's statement of participant's inability to participate. Please allow 3-4 weeks for refund by mail. Refunds or credits will be given for classes cancelled by SPRD.

Programs cancelled by the Streetsboro Senior Center you will receive a full refund of program fees. If you must cancel for any reason including illness, please give at least 7 days notice prior to the program date. Refunds will be given only if no expenses/ticket purchases have occurred. Approved refunds will be applied as a program credit for future programs. If a refund check is requested, there will be a \$5 processing fee. Any cancellations within 7 days of the program will not receive a credit or refund. You are welcome to have someone take your place.

**Deadline Policy/Fee:** If a program is registered for after the noted deadline, SPRD reserves the right to add a fee. If there are not enough participants registered by the noted program deadline, SPRD reserves the right to cancel the program. Please contact SPRD for applicable fee amounts.

**Errors and Mistakes:** Although our staff works hard to ensure each program guide is free from mistakes, there are moments when errors in dates, times, rates or registration information occurs. We will do everything possible to make corrections, and we thank you for your understanding when these situations arise.

**B**icentennial Worship Service at Streetsboro's Historic Methodist Church, located at: Hale Farm & Village Meetinghouse in Bath, Ohio, originally stood at Streetsboro Public Square.

The original Baptist church was built in 1852 with hand-hewed timbers cut locally, with foundation stone quarried at Twinsburg. It was hauled by ox teams to the site which stood at the center of town on the SW corner of the square.

The Baptist congregation presented the building to the Methodists as the Baptist congregation discontinued services.

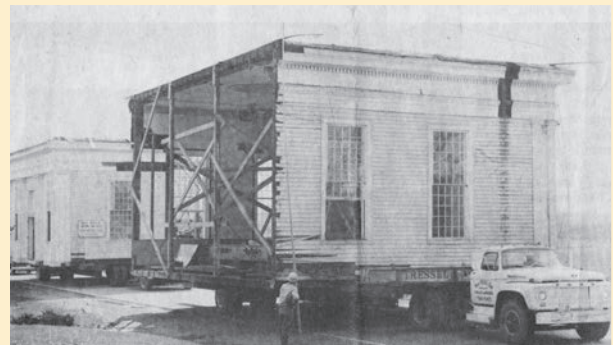
The Methodists, remodeled, dug out a three-room basement and rededicated the church on Sunday, September 10, 1899. At this time, it also served the Presbyterians and Methodists as they held Sunday school services on alternate Sundays. In 1920, an agreement was reached that the Presbyterians would merge with the Methodists and become one Streetsboro Methodist Church.

On May 12, 1956, a tornado completely destroyed the graceful spire of the church and it was the decision of the congregation not to rebuild it.

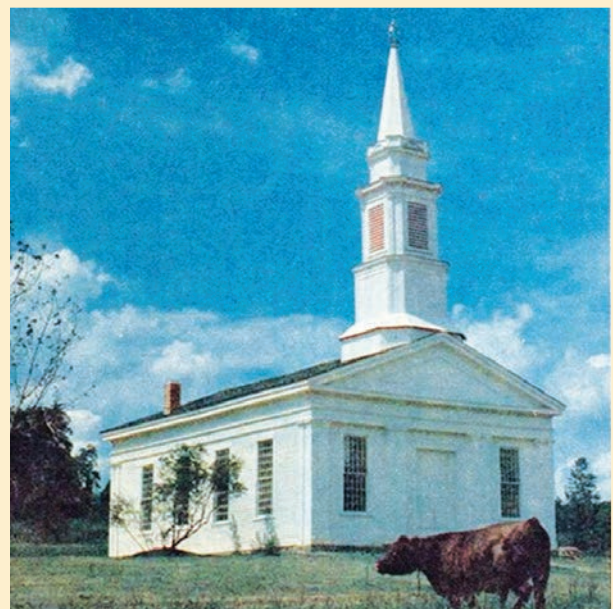
In 1959, the congregation voted to purchase a tract of land on State Route 43, one-quarter mile south of the square, a building fund began and it was decided to relocate to a new church on the new property at a future date. The new church was completed in 1965.

In 1973, the old Western Reserve style church, was moved 28 miles in two sections to the Hale Farm & Village Homestead in Bath, Ohio. The church, is now known as The Mary Ann Sears Swetland Memorial Meetinghouse.

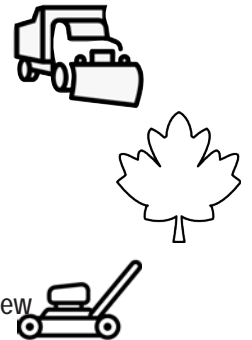

### **Eligibility:**

Eligibility is based on age and/or a documented disability, income, living in a single family owner occupied home and year round residency in the home.

Income eligible applicants will either be:

- Someone at least 65 years of age and be the property owner of record residing at the address on the application.  
Or
- A property owner living with a disability that prevents them from raking leaves, mowing their yard or removing snow.

To be income eligible, the following guidelines apply:

- If you are a one person household, your annual gross income (before taxes) must be at or below \$42,750.
- If you are a two person household, your combined annual gross income (before taxes) must be at or below \$48,850.
- If you are a three person household, your combined annual gross income (before taxes) must be at or below \$54,950.

In addition to documents verifying income, all applicants must provide:

- Proof of age with a current Ohio Driver's License, State of Ohio ID card or Birth Certificate.
- If disabled, a medical certification in the form of a letter from their physician as proof of disability is required.

City Park serves the residents of Streetsboro as a true “Community Park.” Conveniently located within the Streetsboro City School’s campus, City Park is enjoyed year round for a variety of recreational activities and events.

## **WILCOX MEMORIAL PARK, 825 ST. RT. 303**

## **PAVILION RENTAL INFORMATION**

Any person or organization wanting to reserve the pavilion at City Park shall obtain a permit from the Parks & Recreation Department. The fee for the use of the pavilion by a Streetsboro resident, business or organization located within the City is \$30 per rental, up to one day. The fee for the use of the pavilion by a non-resident, business or organization not located within the City is \$50 per rental, up to one day.

Please follow the guidelines listed below when confirming a rental:

- All rental fees are due at the time of the reservation
- Rentals will be granted on a first come, first serve basis
- Residents of Streetsboro may make pavilion rentals up to 1 year in advance
- Non-residents may make pavilion rentals 6 months in advance
- A \$25 additional cleaning fee may be assessed if the facility is not found in a clean condition

### **Pets**

All pets must be on a leash at all times when on City property (with exception of the Dog Park). Pets and owners may be asked to leave and not return at the discretion of the Parks & Recreation staff at any time.
