Special Business

T-7437 Adopt 2024 Tax Budget

Matt Miller said this was the annual requirement to submit to Portage County in order to have them levy the taxes and the set rates on the real property. He said he had collaborated with the department heads over the last month or so to calculate the revenues; they had been very conservative on their projections. He asked for this to go through three readings and be passed on July 10, 2023 to meet the submission deadline of July 15, 2023. He said the three readings would give time for Council to ask any questions they may have. Once this was passed the revenue projections would be locked for the appropriations budget that would be done in December 2023.

T-7438 Ratify CRA Agreement/Mr. Freeze

Mr. O'Malia said the City had negotiated a very small tax incentive for a new cold storage warehouse. He said cold storage operations were usually good tax revenue generators because the working conditions can be chilly and the workers were typically offered a premium wage to work

in such an environment. The City had concluded its negotiations and had offered a very conservative package of 30% real property tax abatement for a five-year term. The developer had agreed to multiple concession to benefit the Streetsboro residents, the City's funds, as well as the Schools and civic organizations. Thirty-one full-time equivalent jobs were expected. There were some incredibly minor changes to the contract that was reviewed earlier in an executive session. The main change was to assign the incentive to a single-purpose LLC that will own the land instead of the ultimate parent company that he had been in communication with. Providing a level of separation between the land and the parent company was not all that uncommon and it did not materially affect any of the provisions of the deal. He recommended substituting the contract he had provided and continue to move the project forward.
