ARTICLE 1 GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 3. Merit Principle

All appointments and promotions shall be made solely on the basis of merit. All positions requiring the performance of the same duties and fulfillment of the same responsibilities shall be assigned to the same class and the same salary range. No applicant for employment or employee shall be deprived on employment opportunities or otherwise adversely affected as an employee because of such individual's race, color, religion, sex national origin, political affiliation, non-disqualifying disability, or age. Employees shall be protected against coercion for partisan political purposes.
