PUBLIC WORKS POLICY #4 STREET LIGHTING STANDARDS

This policy supplements the Subdivision Ordinance 4-4.19 for street lighting within new subdivisions and reflects specific standards. These standards also apply to specific requests by citizens throughout our community, therefor the following standards shall apply.

The Town of Swansboro currently accepts two types of street lighting. The Lighting for residential streets is a sodium vapor 46 kwh, 9500 lumen enclosed light. Residential subdivisions requesting decorative lighting may install the Village Collection (Acorn) fixture, type A, sodium vapor 9500 lumen 100 watt black fiberglass pole. The minimum height will be 16 feet. The minimum distance will be one light per every Ten residences or as determined by the Swansboro Public Works Supervisor.

Plans for Street lighting showing details of locations must be submitted for approval by the Public Works Supervisor prior to acceptance of a proposal.
