ditional priority areas








identified, implemen-





Garbage and Recycling Collection



The Town of Swansboro contracts with GFL to pick up garbage and recycling for households within the Town. Receptacles are available through Town Hall. TRASH PICK UP DAY IS EVERY THURSDAY; RECYCLING PICKUP IS EVERY OTHER THURS-DAY. Trash must be in sealed plastic bags and placed in the trash cart. Pick up begins at 7 a.m. Container should be placed at the street the night before. Your monthly bill will appear on your ONWASA statement. Carts must be removed from the streets within 24 hours of service. No dumping or burning is permitted in the Town of Swansboro town limits. If collection issues arise, please call Town Hall: 910-326-4428.


