


Community Context


Please tell me if you approve or disapprove of the job they are doing.

How likely are you to recommend living in your community on a scale of 1 to 10, with 1 being Extremely Unlikely and 10 being Extremely Likely to recommend?






Views on the Tamalpais Community Services District

As far as you know, what services does the Tamalpais Community Services District provide in your area?








Views on Parks and Recreation Facilities






Voters are most satisfied with the open space and grassy areas and walking paths at Eastwood Park.



What specific improvements would you like to see at Kay and Eastwood Parks? (Open-ended; Grouped Responses Shown, 2% and Above Shown)






Improved bathrooms are the top driver of increased park use.






Q10. *Total More Likely = Kay Park, Eastwood Park & Both Parks

A majority agree that dogs should be off leash but under voice control in designated areas in Eastwood Park.


Which of the following statements comes closest to your personal opinion?





A majority have the same opinion when it comes to Kay Park.


Which of the following statements comes closest to your personal opinion?

Thinking about the other facilities managed by TCSD, how would you rate the condition of each: excellent, good, only fair, poor?






Tamalpais Community Service District Events

Have you ever attended a community event hosted by TCSD?






Those who have attended an event favor live music, Creekside Fridays, and the farmers market.



In a few words of your own, what are some things that could be <u>improved</u> about the TCSD events you have attended?



Why have you not attended any of TCSD community events? (Open-ended; Asked of No Voters Only, n=64)






Voters are most interested in Hazardous Waste Day and more activities for adults.

Please indicate if you're very interested, somewhat interested, not too interested,



What other community events would you like to see offered by TCSD? (Open-ended; 2% and Above Grouped Responses Shown)






Nearly three-quarters are interested in a new centrally located park.

How interested are you in having a new centrally located park in your community?






Customer Service and Communications

Have you or anyone in your household had direct contact with the Tamalpais Community Services District?






Those who has contact with the District were overwhelmingly satisfied.

(Asked of Those Who Had Contact with the District Voters, n=144)





Here is a list of ways TCSD may have provided you with information in the last 12 months. Please tell me if you recall receiving information from TCSD in this way in the last 12 months.






Voters want to see TCSD focus on waste and recycling and community events in the coming years.

Conclusions

Conclusions

- TCSD voters have a very positive view of the District and are highly satisfied with the services offered, although they are most familiar with the solid waste services.
 - Those who have had contact with the District are very satisfied with the service they received.
- Eastwood Park is most visited, and voters are highly satisfied with the open space and walking paths in both parks.
- Ensuring bathrooms are clean is a top priority for voters.
- When it comes to dogs, majorities favor designated off-leash areas where dogs can be under voice control.
- Most respondents have attended a TCSD event with live music and Creekside Fridays the most common favorites.
- Voters are interested in a wide array of additional events, particularly Hazardous Waste Days and more activities for adults.
- Additionally a wide majority across demographic groups were interested in a new centrally located park.
- Voters most want to see the District continuing to focus on waste and recycling, events, its current services, wastewater and parks in the coming years.
