Code Enforcement Sweeps

The City is issuing notices to residents and businesses not in compliance with ordinances. Warnings are usually issued to give residents an opportunity to address and resolve issues before citations are given. Frequent violations include branches not bundled, debris in yard or porch, derelict vehicles and tall grass and weeds. For more information contact City Hall at 789-2892.

Big Trash Pickups Scheduled

Big trash pickups have been scheduled for October. Each ward has a Wednesday assigned as follows:

Ward 1, October 5 Ward 3, October 19
Ward 2, October 12 Ward 4, October 26

Certain items are prohibited including refrigerators (with Freon chlorofluorocarbons), oil, batteries, tires or paint. Wood must be cut to 3 ft. increments and branches should be bundled in 3ft. lengths. If you have any questions, contact Earl Hayes, Sanitation Supervisor at 491-6474. Local businesses including AutoZone recycle oil and car batteries. Big O Tires will accept tires with a \$1.00 disposal fee per tire. In the event of severe weather approaching the City of Warr Acres, please tune in to your local media and be ready to take appropriate action quickly. If a tornado warning is issued for a storm that is threatening to Warr Acres, the tornado sirens will sound. These sirens are tested every Saturday at noon.

Adoptable Animals Available

The Warr Acres animal shelter has numerous animals available for adoption. Adoption fee is \$45 and includes spay/neuter and rabies shot. For more information, contact Animal Control at 789-9025. If you are a pet owner, please be responsible and keep your animals safe and up-to-date on all vaccinations. License is required by ordinance (\$5) for all cats and dogs; should your pet ever escape, the license will help reunite your four-legged family member with you.
