

**Dumpster Days Scheduled**

The Sanitation Department is starting a six-month trial service starting Saturday, Dec. 3 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. This will allow Warr Acres residents to take oversized items to a dumpster set at the Public Works service area, 6045 NW 50 St. The service will run at the same times on the first and third Saturdays of each month during this period. Residents must bring photo identification and their Warr Acres utility bill. Certain items are prohibited including refrigerators (with Freon chlorofluorocarbons), oil, batteries, tires or paint. **Parking Ordinance Clarified**

City Council passed an ordinance in October that restricts parking of vehicles to a hard surface. Hard surface is defined in Title 12 (search municipal codes online at [www.warracres-ok.gov](http://www.warracres-ok.gov)). **Citizens May Make Anonymous Complaints**

Many residents are uncomfortable reporting code violations, disturbance of the peace or other non-emergency incidents if required to identify themselves. However, residents may report such incidents and simply request anonymity by calling direct lines at City Hall instead of using 9-1-1. For non-emergency police matters, call 789-0282. For code violations, leave a detailed message for the City Inspector at 789-2892.

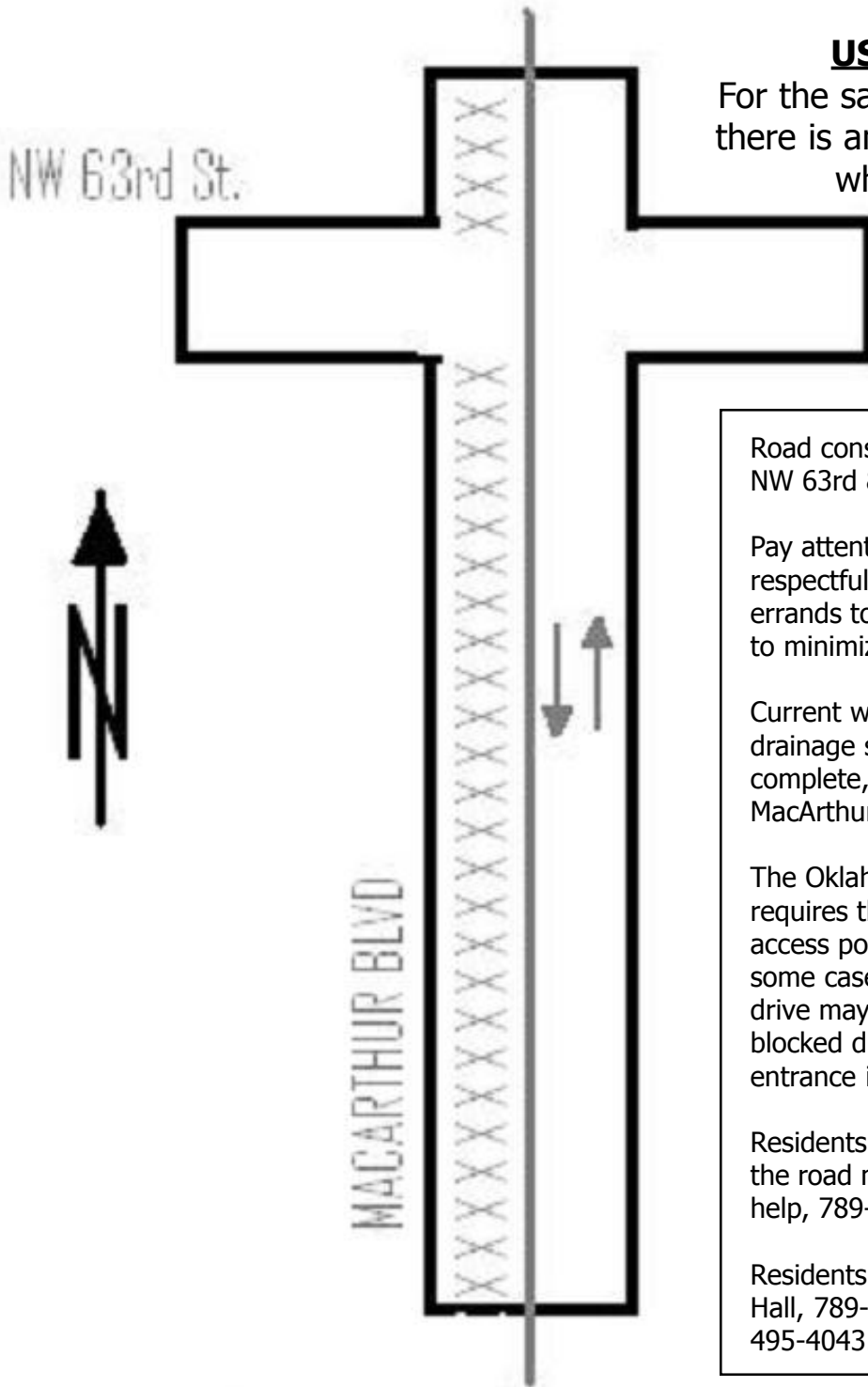

# MacArthur Project Update



## **USE EXTREME CAUTION**

For the safety of workers on the roadway, there is an enhanced penalty for speeding when workers are present.

Road construction begins at the intersection of NW 63rd & MacArthur.

Pay attention to posted signage...and be respectful of drivers around you. Plan your errands to avoid the area at peak traffic times to minimize delays.

Current work is underway on the storm water drainage system at this intersection. Once complete, work will begin on the west lanes of MacArthur.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation requires the contractor to maintain at least one access point to properties along MacArthur. In some cases businesses with more than one drive may have one of these access points blocked during construction so long as another entrance is still accessible.

Residents needing special assistance crossing the road may call the police department for help, 789-0282.
