NEW YEARLY SEWER AVERAGES FOR RESIDENTIAL SEWER BEGIN ON THIS BILL

This is the first month that your new sewer average is reflected on your bill. Your sewer rates are calculated from your water usage we receive from Oklahoma City and Bethany Water Departments. Every year the Oklahoma City and the Bethany Water Departments forwards to the City of Warr Acres a three (3) months average consumption of water usage for each residential property for the winter months of December, January and February. These three months are used because they are the months with the least amount of water being used during the year. The City of Warr Acres then takes this three (3) months winter average and figures the next year's sewer rates. This means that your sewer bill starting this month through April 2020 may have an increase, decrease, or your rate may remain the same depending on how much water consumption you had during December 2018 and January and February 2019.

WARR ACRES BOND ISSUE PASSES!

Mayor Jim Mickley would like to personally thank all of the citizens of Warr Acres. Mayor Mickley is extremely proud of the citizens of Warr Acres for recognizing that their city needed their support in order to move forward.

GARAGE SALES IN WARR ACRES: A PERMIT IS REQUIRED to hold a garage sale in Warr Acres. The first two in a calendar year are free with a fee of \$5.00 for every subsequent sale after that. Garage sales can be held no more than once every three months. Following is a list of helpful safety tips when holding a garage sale:

- 1. Do not advertise the sale as a "Moving Sale," which implies the house may be vacant for a long period of
- 2. Do NOT answer questions about alarm systems, daytime/nighttime occupancy, etc
- 3. **Keep a phone** on your person to report any suspicious activity.
- 4. Place expensive items near you (usually by the checkout table)
- 5. Watch your cash box and keep only a minimal amount of cash on site.
- 6. It's preferable to not accept checks from strangers.
- 7. Always have at least two adults present during your garage sale.
- 8. BE VISIBLE. Do not go inside when there is no-one around. You may miss some customers and some of your merchandise while you are inside. Let one of your helpers know if you go inside.
- 9. Don't block the view to your front door or side gate.
- 10. **LOCK UP THE HOUSE**. Always keep your house locked and no windows left open.
- 11. NEVER allow anyone to go inside your house. If they need a toilet, direct them to the nearest gas station, fast food restaurant or shopping mall.

BULK TRASH DAY INFORMATION

The City of Warr Acres has bulk trash pickup every three (3) months; the next bulk trash day will take place in July. Your bulk trash day will be listed on your Warr Acres utility bill, the newsletter and on the city's Facebook page. You are permitted to put your bulk trash items out three (3) days prior to your big trash day There is a limit to how much trash you

can put out, and if you exceed this amount, you will be charged extra on your utility bill. The amount you can put out is eight (8) cubic yards, which is equal to what one can place in the back of 2 full size pickup beds. A base flat fee of thirty-five (35.00) dollars shall be made for the removal of the material up to and including the first cubic vard. Additional material may be included and removed at a charge of fifteen (15) dollars per cubic yard up to a maximum of forty 40 cubic yards (Ord. 1124, 2012)

According to City Ordinance, grass needs to be cut before it reaches 12 inches in height. If your grass is 12 inches or more in height, you are in violation of City Ordinance and may be subjected to corrective action or a fine. If you have a code violation to report, please report it to City Hall and it will be turned over to Code Enforcement.

E-PAY: PAY YOUR BILL ON THE WEBSITE

The City of Warr Acres offers E-Pay as a utility payment option.

You will need to enter a 5-digit PIN NUMBER when registering. This PIN NUMBER is located ON YOUR UTILITY BILL on the top left. To sign up, please go to our website: www.warracres-ok.gov and follow the instructions. You will no longer receive a paper utility bill and you will be charged a convenience fee that goes to the payment processing service. If you would still like to receive a paper bill, and you would like your utility payment drafted directly out of your account, you may sign up for direct billing authorization. The form to sign up is available in City Hall, please note that the direct billing authorization process takes up to two billing cycles before it kicks in.
