For those whose normal trash day is Monday - there will be a CURBSIDE ONLY pickup on Wednesday, September 4, 2019. If you are participating in curb side pick-up, make sure your trash is out by 5:30am.



REMEMBER – SCHOOL HAS STARTED AGAIN!

Please stay alert to children walking to and from area schools.

Pay particular attention to the school crosswalks. The crossing guards are public safety employees and work under the supervision of the Chief of Police. Failure to follow such direction is subject to traffic laws and may result in conviction or fines.



5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR UTILITY BILL

1. **BY MAIL** – Please allow 7-10 days for delivery of the mail. This will avoid a late fee.
2. **ACH – AUTOMATIC DRAFT** – Please come to City Hall to sign up for this service. A voided check is required and there is no fee for this payment method. ACH payments are drafted on the 5th of each month. Please keep in mind that it may take up to two billing cycles for the ACH to take effect.
3. **IN PERSON** – City Hall is open 8:00 to 5:00 to accommodate those residents who prefer to pay their bill in person.
4. **NIGHT DROP** – There is a night drop box on the west wall located to the right of the main entrance doors. Please make sure your account number **AND** service address is on the check or money order so that the payment may be correctly applied to your account. If there aren't **two** identifying factors along with the payment, it will be sent back to you.
5. **E-Bill** – The City website has a sign-up button which will link you to a 3rd party vendor through which payment may be made. There is a small fee for this service and you must have your bill available as there is a PIN # printed on it which is required to set up your account.

WARR ACRES BOND UPDATE

Plans are 90% complete on the South Macarthur Project; right of ways have started and environmental studies have been completed. The actual roadwork should start early 2020. Solicitation of architects and engineers for the police station, fire station and animal control building will hopefully be completed in late August. Residential road repairs should start in September.
