HALLOWEEN: SAFETY TIPS AND TRICKS

- 1. Avoid trick-or-treating alone. Walk in groups or with a trusted adult.
- 2. Fasten reflective tape to costumes and bags to help drivers see the children.
- 3. Examine all treats for choking hazards and tampering before allowing your children to eat them.
- 4. Hold a flashlight while trick-or-treating to help you see and others to see you.
- 5. Look both ways before crossing the street. Use established crosswalks wherever possible.
- 6. Wear well-fitting masks, costumes, and shoes to avoid blocked vision, trips and falls.

FIRE PREVENTION TIPS: FROM THE WARR ACRES FIRE DEPARTMENT



LOOK

<u>Look for places fire could start.</u> Take a good look around your home. Identify potential fire hazards and take care of them.

LISTEN

<u>Listen for the sound of the smoke alarm.</u> You could have only minutes to escape safely once the smoke alarm sounds. Go to your outside meeting place, which should be a safe distance from the home and where everyone should know to meet.

LEARN

<u>Learn two ways out of every room</u> and make sure all doors and windows leading outside open easily and are free of clutter

HELP KEEP WARR ACRES NEAT AND CLEAN

SANITATION DEPARTMENT – ICE AND SNOW

The sanitation department has always attempted to provide garbage service throughout the city regardless of the weather. When the city experiences ice storms, we must alter the way we gather the garbage for the safety of our workers. For the safety of our citizens, it is suggested that they hold their trash until the next scheduled pick up day.

When there is **ICE on the ground**, garbage "will not be picked up." When there is **SNOW on the ground**, garbage "will be picked up Curbside only."
