

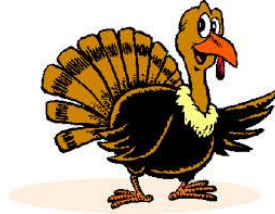

WARR ACRES LIBRARY NEWS

What's Up at Warr Acres Library?

Hello, Warr Acres residents! When was the last time you visited Warr Acres Library at 5901 NW 63rd Street near the Walmart? My name is Laura Warren and I am the new Library Manager. I started here in April of this year and I love serving this community. I want to make sure you are aware of the wealth of free resources and programs available to you with your library account beyond all our books. I will begin sharing information in this newsletter monthly to keep you updated about all that's available to you just for living in Warr Acres. In this installment I thought we would start with the basics. Opening a library account is as simple as presenting a form of identification with your current address.

What do I get with my library account, you might ask?

You may check out 100 items from our selection of books, audiobooks, DVDs, magazines, and music. These items check out for a three-week time period and can be renewed up to eight times if they aren't on hold for another customer. You also have access to all our digital resources like Kanopy, Hoopla, Overdrive and Libby in addition to hundreds of databases on a wide range of topics.

What if we don't have the item you're looking for?

You're in luck because chances are it's available at one of our other 18 branches across the Metro and we can get it sent here for you to pick up. Materials can be returned to any of our branches regardless of where they were checked out and you can renew your materials online, if needed.

What else can I do at the library?

There are lots of free resources, services and programs that are available to the general public and require no library account at all. We offer free faxing (local and long distance), free scanning of documents to an email or flash drive, and free access to public computers. We charge 10 cents for black and white copies and 50 cents for color copies. In addition to all these resources, we have free programs for all ages. Find one that interests you at www.metrolibrary.org under the Attend tab at the top of the page. **Please mark your calendars for Thursday January 23, 2020, there will be a meet and greet with the Mayor of Warr Acres to explain the status of all parts of the bond issue.**

ZIP CODE REMINDER

Please be sure to use your Warr Acres zip code along with the 4-digit code when purchasing items online. This helps to ensure that Warr Acres receives the tax money on this and that your taxes do not go to Oklahoma City. If you are not sure what 4-digit code you need to put after your zip code, you may contact the Post Office to obtain this information. You may also use their website at <https://tools.usps.com/go/zip-code-lookup.htm>. Once you input the requested information, it will let you know what your 4-digit code is.

SANITATION DEPARTMENT – ICE AND SNOW

The sanitation department has always attempted to provide garbage service throughout the city regardless of the weather. When the city experiences ice storms, we must alter the way we gather the garbage for the safety of our workers. For the safety of our citizens, it is suggested that they hold their trash until the next scheduled pick up day.

When there is **ICE on the ground**, garbage “will not be picked up.” When there is **SNOW on the ground**, garbage “**will be picked up Curbside only.**”
