

SANITATION RATE INCREASE: COMMERICAL AND RESIDENTIAL

The City Council approved an increase in your utility rates of 7 dollars per month for both commercial and residential garbage. This will be reflected on your December billing. This was to make up for a shortfall in sanitation revenue that was coming out of the city's general fund and we could no longer afford to cover this loss.

<u>JANUARY IS RESIDENTIAL BIG TRASH PICKUP MONTH</u>

Ward 1 Wednesday January 8, 2020

Ward 2 Wednesday January 15, 2020

Ward 3 Wednesday January 22, 2020

Ward 4 Wednesday January 29, 2020

Big Trash <u>INCLUDES</u>, but is not limited to: household appliances, furniture, carpet, mattresses, box springs, water tanks, fencing and similar non-contracted items, bagged grass, and brush produced as refuse from single-family dwellings. Compressors must be removed from all appliances **BEFORE** collection may be completed. Doors on refrigerators and other bulky items **MUST** be removed before placement on curb.

Items **EXCLUDED** under the definition of big trash include hospital and medical waste, poisons, acids and caustics, explosives, dirt and rocks, sewage and liquid waste, nuclear materials, gasoline, kerosene, propane tanks, degreasers, lubricants, tires and rims, antifreeze, paint, and commercial construction debris, bricks or concrete. Call sanitation at 491-6474 if you have any questions.

SIZE OF MATERIAL: Big trash shall be a length not exceeding 10 feet or a weight exceeding 250 pounds. Tree trimmings and branches must be placed together in piles with individual branches not longer than 8 feet and dead trees (not more than 6 inches in diameter).

The TOTAL amount allowed at the curb is 8 cubic yards (equal to what you can place in the back of 2 full size pickup beds level with the top of the cab). There will be an additional fee of \$15.00 for each cubic yard of bulky waste collected in excess of eight (8) cubic yards

Items cannot be placed out for pick-up earlier than four days preceding the regularly scheduled bulk waste collection day <u>FOR YOUR WARD</u>.

<u>PLACEMENT AND LOCATION</u> of big trash: Items shall be placed at least five feet (5') from mailboxes, cars, shrubs, or anything else that could interfere with hand loading or mechanical equipment. Items shall be placed at least ten feet (10') away from utility poles, guywires, signs, fire hydrants and gas meters to allow mechanized pick up.





Samaritan EMS Contact Information

As a citizen of Warr Acres, since you pay a subsidy amount added to your utility bill, your medically necessary ambulance transport services are covered. For more information regarding this service, please feel free to inquire at memberservices@samaritanemsok.com or call the toll-free number at 1-844-498-6471. The subsidy paid to Samaritan does not cover the transport fee for taking an EMSA ambulance if sick or injured outside of Warr Acres, Bethany, and Yukon. If you are concerned about being injured outside of Warr Acres, you can join EMSAcare as a direct subscriber online at emsaonline.com or calling 405-396-2888.

Sanitation Department: Ice and Snow Information

The sanitation department has always attempted to provide garbage service throughout the city regardless of the weather. When the city experiences ice storms, we must alter the way we gather the garbage for the safety of our workers. For the safety of our citizens, it is suggested that they hold their trash until the next scheduled pick up day. When there is **ICE on the ground**, garbage **will not be picked up**. When there is **SNOW on the ground**, garbage **will be picked up curbside only.**
