CITY HALL WILL BE CLOSED ON

PRESIDENT'S DAY Monday February 17, 2020

Have your trash at the curb by **5:30 a.m.** the morning of **CURBSIDE** pickup or the night before.

BUSINESS SAFETY INSPECTIONS

The Warr Acres Fire Department will be conducting Business Safety Inspections in an effort to eliminate, correct, and reduce hazards. These inspections/pre-fire plans are designed to help prevent fires while protecting life and property. Some common code violations we have seen in previous years which require correction include: out of date/untagged extinguishers, blocked exits, blocked electrical panels, malfunctioning emergency lighting, no exit signage, and untagged sprinkler systems.
