HOLIDAY SEASON! Please keep these safety tips in mind:



- When shopping, try to park in a well-lit area.
- **NEVER** leave valuables visible inside your vehicle. Place all items out of sight, inside your trunk.
- **REMAIN AWARE** of your surroundings when walking to and from your car.
- NEVER leave your car unoccupied with the motor running or with children inside regardless of how close you are.
- Whenever possible, **shop during daylight hours**. If you must shop at night, go with a friend or family member.
- AVOID carrying large amounts of cash.
- Criminals commonly take advantage of the generosity of people during the holiday season by soliciting donations. Thoroughly investigate a charity before giving any donation.
- If you are having packages delivered while you are at work or away, have a trusted neighbor or friend retrieve the
 packages for you soon after they are delivered.
- Be extra vigilant about locking doors and windows when you leave the house.
- REPORT suspicious people or activities to Warr Acres police immediately. Call 911 for all emergencies or 789-3329.

E-PAY: PAY YOUR BILL ON THE WEBSITE

The City of Warr Acres offers E-Pay as a utility payment option.

You will need to enter a 5-digit **PIN NUMBER** when registering. This PIN NUMBER is located **ON YOUR UTILITY BILL** on the **top left**. To sign up, please go to our website: <u>www.warracres-ok.gov</u> and follow the instructions. You will no longer receive a paper utility bill and you will be charged a convenience fee that goes to the payment processing service. If you would still like to receive a paper bill, and you would like your utility payment drafted directly out of your account, you may sign up for direct billing authorization. The form to sign up is available in City Hall, please note that the direct billing authorization process takes up to two billing cycles before it kicks in.

ZIP CODE REMINDER

<u>Please be sure to use your Warr Acres zip code along with the 4-digit code when purchasing items online</u>. This helps to ensure that Warr Acres receives the tax money on this and that your taxes do not go to Oklahoma City. If you are not sure what 4-digit code you need to put after your zip code, you may contact the Post Office to obtain this information. You may also use their website at <u>https://tools.usps.com/go/zip-code-lookup.htm</u>. Once you input the requested information, it will let you know what your 4-digit code is.

SANITATION DEPARTMENT – ICE AND SNOW

The sanitation department has always attempted to provide garbage service throughout the city regardless of the weather. When the city experiences ice storms, we must alter the way we gather the garbage for the safety of our workers. For the safety of our citizens, it is suggested that they hold their trash until the next scheduled pick up day.

When there is **ICE on the ground**, garbage "will not be picked up." When there is **SNOW on the ground**, garbage "will be picked up Curbside only."
