Recycling

Recycling dumpsters are available at Dorothy Cavener Park, in the area of NW 52nd and Hammond Avenue. **The Recycle center will be open Saturdays only from 8:30am until 11:30am.** The Recycle Center is not open in January or July due to the weather. HOME BASED BUSINESSES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN A RESIDENTIALLY ZONED AREA IN WARR ACRES IF

1. You **USE** mechanical equipment which creates any noise, dust, or odor beyond your property.
2. You **STORE** equipment, machinery, materials or trucks in excess of one ton on your property.
3. Employees are arriving at your home who do **NOT** live in the home.
4. You **EXPAND** your existing driveway to accommodate clients, employees, OR a company car, truck, or trailer.
5. Your business activity takes place **OUTSIDE THE MAIN HOUSE.**
(per Title 5 and Title 19 of the Warr Acres Ordinance)



ENVIRONMENTAL TIPS

- Mowing – Follow the “Don’t Bag It” plan. Leave grass clippings and sweep stray grass back into your lawn after mowing.

- Saves the following:

- Environment – Grass clippings that are swept off the street are kept out of storm drains. This helps prevent pollutants from reaching our rivers and lakes.
- Money– Uses less garbage bags, serves as a natural fertilizer and reduces bulky

trash.

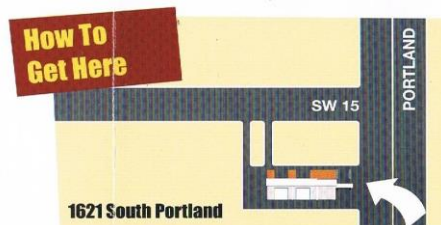
- Time – “Don’t Bag It” reduces your annual mowing time by one-third.
- Non-toxic products are better for your plants. They also reduce potential toxic run-off that ends up in local creeks and rivers.
- Sweep excess fertilizer on sidewalks and streets back into lawn.
- Manually water your lawn after applying fertilizer and never apply fertilizer before rainstorms.
- Take leftover fertilizer and pesticide products to the Household Hazardous Waste Facility for free disposal.
- Pet waste contains phosphorus, nitrogen, and harmful bacteria to humans, animals and environment.
- Picking up pet waste prevents these pollutants from getting carried to local waterways during rainstorms

Residents with leftover paint, stripper, drain cleaners, old batteries and other hazardous waste may load these items up and bring them to the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility at 1621 South Portland. Please do not put the above items in with your regular trash items.

The Center is free for residents of Warr Acres; however, you must take a water bill or trash/sewer bill with you as proof of residency.
