HALLOWEEN: SAFETY TIPS AND TRICKS

- 1. Avoid trick-or-treating alone. Walk in groups or with a trusted adult.
- 2. Fasten reflective tape to costumes and bags to help drivers see the children.
- 3. Examine all treats for choking hazards and tampering before allowing your children to eat them.
- 4. Hold a flashlight while trick-or-treating to help you see and others to see you.
- 5. Look both ways before crossing the street. Use established crosswalks wherever possible.
- 6. Wear well-fitting masks, costumes, and shoes to avoid blocked vision, trips and falls.

IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE WARR ACRES FIRE DEPARTMENT

Portable generators are themselves life-saving emergency safety tools; however, because of improper use, year-afteryear, people suffer carbon monoxide poisoning. This was particularly true in October 2020 and February 2021. During the ice storm and the extreme cold, carbon monoxide poisonings increased, and portable generators were the primary culprit. We want to remind you to follow the manufactures' recommendations for generator placement. Operate portable generators outside only and keep them at least 20 feet away from the home, facing away from all structures. We also urge everyone to install battery-operated carbon monoxide alarms near sleeping areas and test them frequently.

• LOOK

Look for places fire could start. Take a good look around your home. Identify potential fire hazards and take care of them.

• LISTEN

Listen for the sound of the smoke alarm. You could have only minutes to escape safely once the smoke alarm sounds. Go to your outside meeting place, which should be a safe distance from the home and where everyone should know to meet.

• LEARN

Learn two ways out of every room and make sure all doors and windows leading outside open easily and are free of clutter
