WARR ACRES BOND UPDATE

- The grading for the new police department is completed and the foundation is about to be poured. This project is on schedule.
- The animal shelter is nearly dried in, just lacking doors, and interior work is ongoing. This project is also on schedule.
- The new city hall location is nearing completion and is on schedule. Flooring and final paint is in progress.
- The new fire station is just waiting on the old city hall to be torn down after the city moves to have construction start on this project. This is on schedule.
- The street projects, both residential and MacArthur widening are on schedule.
- We have completed all major sewer projects scheduled for 2020.



HALLOWEEN: SAFETY TIPS AND TRICKS

1. Avoid trick-or-treating alone. Walk in groups or with a trusted adult.
2. Fasten reflective tape to costumes and bags to help drivers see the children.
3. Examine all treats for choking hazards and tampering before allowing your children to eat them.
4. Hold a flashlight while trick-or-treating to help you see and others to see you.
5. Look both ways before crossing the street. Use established crosswalks wherever possible.
6. Wear well-fitting masks, costumes, and shoes to avoid blocked vision, trips and falls.

- **LOOK**
Look for places fire could start. Take a good look around your home. Identify potential fire hazards and take care of them.
- **LISTEN**
Listen for the sound of the smoke alarm. You could have only minutes to escape safely once the smoke alarm sounds. Go to your outside meeting place, which should be a safe distance from the home and where everyone should know to meet.
- **LEARN**
Learn two ways out of every room and make sure all doors and windows leading outside open easily and are free of clutter
