To the Constable of the Town of Wendell in the County of Franklin,
Greetings,

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, at the Town Hall in said Town on **Wednesday, January 31, 2024 at 7 pm**, then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the School Committee to enter into a five (5) year contract, commencing on July 1, 2024 with F. M. Kuzmeskus to provide school transportation services for the Town, subject to the School Committee's determination that the contract is in the best interests of the Town and subject annually to Town Meeting approval for funding for these services and/or take any vote or votes in relation thereto.


ARTICLE 2: To transact any other legal business that may come before said meeting, or take any action thereon.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up attested copies thereof at the Wendell Town Office Building, **14 days** at least prior to the time of holding said meeting.
