A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF CONTINUING THE EXISTING CITY INCOME TAX TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSES OF POLICE, FIRE AND OTHER GENERAL OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO, AND PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF SAID QUESTION FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE ELECTORS.

*WHEREAS*, the amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy of an income tax within the limitations prescribed by Section 718.01 of the Ohio Revised Code and the amounts presently imposed by the City of West Carrollton, will be insufficient to provide funds for operating expenses for the City of West Carrollton, therefore making it necessary to continue the levy in excess of said limitations.

*NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, STATE OF OHIO, HEREBY RESOLVES:*

Section 1: That the Council of the City of West Carrollton declares that the amount of money that may be raised by the levy of an income tax within the limitations established by Section 718.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, together with all other funds available will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for financing of general operating expenses for said City, and that it is necessary for Council to pass an ordinance, attached hereto and made a part hereof, renewing a one-fourth of one percent tax in addition to the previous two percent tax presently being imposed, making a total rate of two and one fourth (2.25) percent of the earnings of persons and corporations who are residents of the City of West Carrollton, and of persons and corporations who are not residents of the City of West Carrollton but are engaged in business in the City, said tax rate to be effective for a continuing period of time beginning on January 1, 2019.

Section 2: That a copy of this Resolution and proposed Ordinance be certified to the Board of Elections of Montgomery County, Ohio, in order that said Board may make the necessary arrangements for submitting the question of such additional levy to the electors of the City of West Carrollton as required by Section 718.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, at the primary election to be held in said City on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May, 2017.

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
Section 3: That the ballot to be presented to said voters shall be in the following form, to wit:

CONTINUATION OF THE EXISTING CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON INCOME TAX FOR POLICE, FIRE AND OTHER GENERAL OPERATING EXPENSES	
Shall Ordinance 3602 providing for the continuation of the existing one-fourth of one percent tax in addition to the previous two percent tax, making a total rate of two and one-fourth (2.25) percent on income for a continuing period of time commencing January 1, 2019, to be used for police, fire and other general operating expenses by the City, be passed? (A majority vote is necessary for passage.)

Section 4: That this Resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage, the earliest period allowed by law.
