

# RECORD OF RESOLUTIONS

Resolution No. 11-2022

Passed: January 25, 2022

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) TO EVALUATE AND CREATE AN ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION PLAN FOR THE FORMER WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY LOCATED ON HYDRAULIC ROAD IN THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Carrollton, Ohio owns the former Appvion Wastewater Treatment Plant located on Hydraulic Road in the City of West Carrollton, Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, the former Appvion Wastewater Treatment Plant has identified environmental contamination on-site which will require remediation prior to the redevelopment of the property; and

**WHEREAS**, the USEPA and the OEPA require the development of a formal environmental remediation plan certified by a Certified Professional and is providing grant funds for public entities to make competitive application to obtain funding for environmental assessment: and

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Carrollton, Ohio is working collaboratively with the Patriot Engineering Group to obtain an award of environmental assessment funds to assess the environmental contamination of the Appvion Wastewater Treatment Plant facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Carrollton, Ohio intends to apply for an environmental grant in the amount of \$300,0000 dollars to fully environmentally assess the Appvion Wastewater Treatment Facility; and

**WHEREAS**, a requirement of the Ohio Department of Development environmental Assessment grant award is the grantee provide a 25% match of the grant amount awarded; and

**WHEREAS**, THE City of West Carrollton, Ohio agrees to provide a 25% match of the grant amount awarded, which if fully funded would be \$75,000 dollars.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO, THAT:**

Section 1: The City Manager and/or his designee is authorized to apply for an Environmental Assessment Grant from the Ohio Department of Development for an estimated amount of \$300,000 dollars


