WHEREAS, a bid package for the restoration of the Windmill was prepared by the Village consultants; and

WHEREAS, the Village received three bids, one of which did not conform to the bid requirements and specifications; and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined to award the Governor John Adams Dix Windmill Restoration Project (the "Project") to the lowest responsible bidder, that is, Ashlar Contracting LLC, 87B Carleton Avenue, Islip Terrace, New York 11752, for the sum of One Million Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,550,000.00) contingent, however, upon the execution of a post-bid award project funding agreement among the Town, Village and Ashlar Contracting LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Westhampton Beach hereby accepts the bid of Ashlar Contracting LLC and awards the Governor John Adams Dix Windmill Restoration Project to Ashlar Contracting LLC for the sum of One Million Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,550,000.00), contingent upon the execution of a post-bid award project funding agreement among the Town, Village and Ashlar Contracting LLC.

Mrs. Levan also asked about the possibility of exceeding the tax cap, Mayor Urban explained that the Village is hoping not to exceed the cap, but the Village Attorney has composed the resolution if the Village needs to pass the Local Law to exceed the cap. Ms. Erin Finley commented about the rate increase, she asked about the staffing at Rogers, she thought there seemed to be a lot; she also asked for a clarification on the chart, she didn't see the change on the copies, she was given a colored copy to clarify, and staffing will be slightly reduced. Ms. Finley asked about the concerts being changed from Thursday to Wednesday, this change was requested by the Library. Mayor Urban asked if there was anyone else in the audience, Mr. Steve McKenna asked the Board about the windmill project, he has an application before the Board to use the Great Lawn. Mayor Urban explained the Board is hoping for a May start date and May 2025 end date. Mr. McKenna stated he understood that the special event permits were being held up, Mayor Urban explained that the special events will continue on the Great Lawn with possible changes to accommodate the construction. Mr. Vincent Fazio asked the

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board about a discussion of the Bocce court, Mayor Urban explained the process it will be discussed at the next work session. Mayor Urban asked if there was anyone else that would like to speak, there being no response he asked for a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss personnel matters, motion made by Deputy Mayor Frano seconded by Trustee Monsour and unanimously approved 3 Ayes, 0 Nays.
