

Conceptual Development Plan - Northwest Corner of Sunset Avenue and Mill Road Design Principles

- Buildings address the street. Primary doorways open onto the street and are designed to attract people to enter from the front sidewalk. Front facades contain ample win-[1] dows and style elements that add interest and character.
- Buildings are built on or close to the front property line with articulation of the facade to provide visual interest and a space for a public plaza or outdoor eating area. [2]
- [3] The buildings located adjacent to said plaza address it in the same way they address streets.
- Buildings are either attached or located close together with openings between them serving primarily as pedestrian and driveway accessways to rear parking lots. [4]
- A mix of single and multi-story buildings with a common set of design organizational elements, while the buildings need not have the same architectural style. [5]
- [6] The off-street parking is located to the rear or side of buildings with most parking located to the rear, with landscaping with screens the parking from the street.



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
