Resolution No. 2016 – 1

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES FOR REVIEWING AND PROCESSING
SEWAGE PERMITS**

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Supervisors of West Mead Township, Crawford County, Pennsylvania, establish fees for the administration and processing of sewage disposal system permits as required under the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act 537 of 1966, as amended, and regulations promulgated thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of West Mead Township, as follows:

1. **Sewage Permit and Sewage Enforcement Officer Fees:** The fees set forth in Schedule "A", which is attached to this Resolution, are adopted as the fees to be charged and collected for the application, administration, testing and processing with respect to requests for sewage disposal system permits, fees for services of the SEO and other matters relating to the administration and enforcement of the sewage facilities laws and regulations, as may be required and appropriated under the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, and the Department of Environmental Protection regulations.
2. **Payment Due Upon Application:** The fees hereby adopted shall be paid at the time application is made, or otherwise required for the administration and processing of the application or regulations, in accordance with applicable laws, ordinances and regulations.
3. **Repeal of Previous Fee Schedules:** Any and all previous sewage permit fee schedules are hereby repealed.
4. **Effective Until Changed:** This schedule of fees shall remain in effect until further Resolution of the Board of Supervisors.



NOTE: All soil evaluation holes and percolation holes must be filled back in with dirt soon as the testing is completed. Lids must be used to cover all percolation holes after preparation and awaiting testing. These holes must remain covered until testing is completed, then filled immediately by the applicant.
