- 1. The Secretary represented West Mead Township at the Joint Road Work bid opening on April 28, 2023 held at the West Mead Township building. Secretary to read bids.**

Motion to award SUPERPAVE Contract for Work on Barton Road, Oakgrove Avenue, Parkway Drive, McGraw Street, Springs Road Extension and McHenry Street to Glenn Hawbaker Inc, for a total of \$315,275.00.

- 2. Motion to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the Crawford County Act 13 Environmental Initiative Fund Grant Contract with the Crawford County Commissioners to add two inclusive play structures to the Playground Area at Oakgrove Park, for a total of \$3,637.73.**

- 3. Motion to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the PA Commission on Crime and Delinquency Grant Contract for various technology upgrades including items such as P25 compliant Handheld Radios, ToughBook Computers, Computer Server and Phone System upgrades for the West Mead Township Police Department, for a total of \$46,639.00.**
