WATER LINE REPAIR ON HAYS STREET

COMMUNITY RECREATION SURVEY

Manager Sheridan said that the results of this survey will be used in future planning efforts in the Village. So far there have been 305 surveys completed and he stated he would like to have at least 500. The survey will be open until March 11, 2022. He would like all families to take the survey. There is a QR code or link available to take this survey.

NEW STREET NAME SIGN DESIGN

Manager Sheridan had some designs on paper for the council to look at. He asked for ideas or other options which were made (bulldog and American flag). Manager Sheridan is going to request some examples from the company so that they can be looked at outside and at night. It was also stated that the plan will be to replace them some at a time and will take several years to replace all.

2022 GOALS AND PRIORITIES

Manager Sheridan provided a new list of possible goals for the council to prioritize for 2022. He requested that the council take some time to look over those and get them back before the next meeting and he would present the results.
