## RESOLUTION ADOPTING A DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT FOR THE NORTH AREA OF STILLWATER CROSSINGS

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio (the "Municipality") intends to facilitate the residential and commercial development of a portion of the Municipality located generally at the northwest corner of intersection of State Route 571 and Iddings Road (the "Stillwater Crossings North Area") all to improve the quality of life for the residents of the Municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, in furtherance of its efforts to cause the residential and commercial development of the Stillwater Crossing North Area and in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5709.40, the Municipality may create incentive district for parcels of real property located within the municipal corporate boundaries of the Municipality, declare improvements to such parcels of real property located in the incentive district to be a public purpose, grant real property tax exemptions for the increased value of real property in the incentive district, require the owners of real property in the incentive district to make service payments in lieu of taxes, and use those service payments in lieu of taxes for various purposes authorized by law; and

**WHEREAS**, in connection with the potential creation of the incentive district, the Municipality has determined to adopt a development agreement in the form attached to, and incorporated into, this Resolution as Exhibit "A" (the "Development Agreement"), with the additional agreement that all other substantial project details must be submitted to the Municipal Manager for approval by Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** Be It Resolved by the Council of the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio that:

#### **SECTION I.**

<u>Development Agreement</u>. This Council hereby adopts the development agreement attached to, and incorporated into, this Resolution as Exhibit "A." All other substantial project details must be submitted to the Municipal Manager for approval by Council.

#### SECTION II.

<u>Further Authorizations</u>. This Council further hereby authorizes and directs the Municipal Manager or other appropriate officers of the Municipality to prepare and sign all agreements and instruments and to take any other actions as may be appropriate to implement this Resolution.

#### **SECTION III.**

<u>Open Meetings</u>. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council

and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law including R.C. Section 121.22.

### A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE EMERGENCY REPAIRS AT THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to replace two failing twenty-one-year-old pumps that serve the Nitrification Towers at the wastewater treatment plant; and

**WHEREAS,** the chosen vendor will provide the make and model of pumps necessary to make this emergency repair swiftly; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Manager is asking Council to waive the bidding process required by Code Section 33.18(A)(3) based on there being no benefit to the Municipality to undertake bidding and that the best interest of the Municipality is served by waiving bidding due to the emergency nature of this matter pursuant to Code Section 33.18(A)(9)(E); and

WHEREAS, the project will be funded out of the 2022 Operating Budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** Be it Resolved by the Council of the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio that:

**SECTION I:** 

The Council hereby waives the bidding process pursuant to Code Section 33.18(A)(9)(E) and approves the purchase of two vortex type pumps from the chosen vendor that can provide said pumps in a reasonable timeframe with a purchase amount not to

exceed \$32,000.00 in total.

**SECTION II:** 

The Municipal Manager and/or the Director of Service are hereby authored to locate the proper pumps, execute all the proper documents required and to complete said purchase.

**SECTION III:**
