### Ordinance CM-23-42

Ordinance CM-23-42 was introduced by council and read in full by Law Director Brosh. AN ORDINANCE DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO RENEW AN EXISTING TAX LEVY FOR THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF THE STREETS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY, INCLUDING THE STORM SEWERS INCIDENT THERETO, AND REQUESTING THE MIAMI COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE VILLAGE AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THE RENEWAL LEVY. Manager Sheridan stated that this was a routine ordinance to maintain the existing levy. This is the first step to get the levy renewal on the ballot in November. This will be voted on after the second reading of the ordinance.
