Garbage and Refuse and recyclables (if applicable) containers shall be placed for collection at the alley line where possible in the right-of-way, off of the street and at the curb line where necessary (greenspace if available). Unless approved by the Director of Service, refuse collection will NOT take place on nonresidential streets to include alleyways. Placement of garbage and refuse for collection shall be the responsibility of the householder, tenant, or *property* owner. 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# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 53.22(B) YARD WASTE DISPOSAL OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST MILTON, OHIO

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio has established its own refuse collection program within the Village of West Milton; and

**WHEREAS,** changes are necessary to provide the safest, best, and most cost-effective yard waste collection service to West Milton residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio needs to make changes by adding and/or deleting language to Section 53.22(B) Yard Waste Disposal.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio hereby ordains as follows, that:

**SECTION I:** 

Section 53.22(B) of the West Milton Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

§53.22 YARD WASTE DISPOSAL.

(B) Various private, commercial, and other parties may create various programs/composting facilities to dispose of yard waste. These programs/composting facilities must comply with the Department of Health's requirements, OEPA rules, the Ohio Administrative Code, and not violate West Milton's nuisance sections. The municipality may encourage voluntary per bag programs to dispose of yard waste through the private sector. The Municipality of West Milton may set dates for yard waste to be hauled by residents and dropped off at a site chosen by the Director of Service. The Municipality of West Milton will establish one day per week, Monday-Friday, for the collection of bagged yard waste, limbs, Christmas trees, etc. All yard waste to be collected MUST be bagged or bundled except for leaves that are collected during the annual leaf collection program. Yard waste collection bags should All loose yard waste set out for collection shall be placed in a bag made of paper and designed to hold **both** wet and dry materials **without easily breaking** open. Bags must be of a reasonable weight where one person can easily load the bag onto a truck or trailer for removal. Bags made of plastic will not be accepted. The Municipality may offer suitable yard waste bags to residents free of charge. The number of free bags given to each resident may vary and will be decided by the Director of **Service.** Bundles of yard waste such as sticks/branches shall be bundled (maximum of 5-foot lengths) and tied securely for easy collection/removal.

**SECTION II:** 

This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date permitted by law.

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# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 53.03(D) STORAGE OF GARBAGE, REFUSE AND RECYCLABLES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST MILTON, OHIO

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio has established its own refuse collection program within the Village of West Milton; and

**WHEREAS,** changes are necessary to provide the safest, best, and most costeffective bulk refuse waste collection service to West Milton residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio needs to make changes by adding and/or deleting language to Section 53.03(D).

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio hereby ordains as follows, that:

SECTION I:

Section 53.03(D) of the West Milton Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

§53.03 STORAGE OF GARBAGE, REFUSE AND RECYCLABLES.

(D) Any large refuse items that will not fit into the residential standard volume or low volume toters shall be considered Bulk Refuse. Normal bulk refuse will be collected once per week on the date chosen by the Director of Service. Until curbside recycling is available, municipal staff shall encourage residents to self-deliver all cardboard to the recycling area for free disposal rather than set it out for bulk collection. During high bulk refuse periods, additional days of collection could be added. Bulk refuse can consist of the following, but not limited to furniture, appliances, mattresses, box springs, televisions, etc. All smaller bulk items set out for collection should not be loose. These items should be boxed, bagged, or bundled. Loose metal or wood planks shall be bundled in three-to-five-foot lengths. Hazardous items will not be collected such as liquid paint, chemicals, and auto batteries, etc. Large rocks and concrete will not be collected. Bulk refuse will not be collected in alleyways. Bulk collection is not intended for entire residential clean-outs. The Director of Service has the authority to deny bulk collection if it is deemed that the bulk quantity is too large. Each household will be limited to four a certain number of bulk collections annually. *This number will be set by the Director of Service* with advice from the Mayor, Council and the Municipal Manager, and be monitored/adjusted if needed. After the set number is reached, the Municipality reserves the right to refuse collection or charge the householder a fee decided upon by the Director of Service or and the Municipal Manager.

**SECTION II:** 

This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
