Annual Utility Rate Increase

Notice a higher utility bill? Each year in January, water and sewer rates are increased by 5%. This was approved by City Council in 2018 by Resolution No. 17-18-11.

The February 15th billing cycle reflects this increase.

Why increase rates?

Maintenance, repair and improvements are important to providing safe drinking water. Increasing the utility rates allow the City to:

- Upgrade facilities (such as the water intake) to allow for long-term savings.
- Maintain and repair facilities
- Cover increasing cost of supplies
- and maintain a contingency fund for unforseen expenses.
