

ORDINANCE NO. 534

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 521, SECTION 7, SUBSECTION (3), AND ADDING NEW SUBSECTION (4) DEALING WITH NUISANCES AFFECTING THE PUBLIC SAFETY, AND AMENDING SECTION 15 DEALING WITH PENALTIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Section 7 (3). Grass, shrubbery, weeds and noxious growth. No person in charge of property shall permit weeds or other noxious vegetation to grow to a height of over 12" upon his property.

(4) No person shall keep junk outdoors on a street, lot or premises or in a building that is not wholly or entirely enclosed except for doors used for ingress and egress. The term "junk" as used in this section includes all old motor vehicles, old motor vehicle parts, abandoned automobiles, old machinery, old machinery parts, old appliances or appliance parts, old iron or other metal, glass, paper, lumber, wood or other waste or discarded material. This section does not apply to junk kept in a licensed junk yard or automobile wrecking yard.

Section 15. Penalties. "imprisonment for a period not to exceed 90 days" shall be eliminated from this section.

Emergency. The council desires and deems it necessary for the preservation of the health, peace and safety of the city of Willamina that this ordinance take effect at once, and therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
