## City Manager news: Citywide Cleanup a Success!

Thank you citizens of Willamina. Code Enforcement heard your request to bring back the Citywide Clean Up and through collaborative efforts we were able to host the Clean Up Day this year. We had a highly successful Citywide Cleanup on Saturday, June 10th. With everyone hauling in debris we were able to dispose 15 tons of garbage, 8.5 tons of scrap metal, and truckloads of yard debris. 400 pounds of food was collected for GrandSheriMina food bank and hundreds of volunteer hours were provided. Thank you to our volunteers, scrappers, city councilors, the Willamina Coastal Hills Chamber of Commerce, Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Emergency Services, Hampton Lumber, Sheridan Rotary and Recology for your support!

We would also like to thank the volunteers that assisted the Mayor with restaining and repairing the benches and wooden border in the City Hall parking lot. We are working on ways to improve and potentially modify the event if we are able to host it again, please continue to work with City Staff to inquire about code concerns to assist us with cleaning up and beautifying our little city.



As a reminder, the construction of the \$12 million dollar water intake relocation and water service line extension to the school will be starting in the coming weeks. This along with the construction of Hampton's super mill, our small cities will start seeing an increase of construction vehicles and large equipment driving through our neighborhoods.
