

ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR LICENSING AND REGULATING THE PUBLIC DANCE IN THE CITY OF WILLAMINA.

The city of Willamina, Oregon, ordains as follows:

Section 1. That any person or persons desiring to conduct any public dance in the city of Willamina shall first secure from the city recorder a license therefor, and shall be required to pay to the said recorder the sum of \$1.00 for each and every dance which shall be conducted in the city of Willamina, Oregon, and which sum shall be paid in advance prior to the opening of said dance. Section 2. No dance shall be allowed to continue later than 1:00 a.m. unless a special permit is obtained prom the city recorder. [Section 2 as amended by Ordinance No. 459, §1, passed August 10, 1978.]

Section 3. It is hereby made the duty of the manager of such dance to maintain good order in and about the place where such dance is being held and to permit no drunk or disorderly person to be present at any such dance.

Section 4. A violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$50.00, nor less than \$25.00. [Section 4 as amended by Ordinance No. 459, §2, passed August 10, 1978.]

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the mayor.
