

ORDINANCE NO. 374

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 244; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WILLAMINA, OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section three (3) of Ordinance Number 244 passed by the council April 28, 1953, and approved by the mayor April 30, 1953, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any minor to purchase acquire, or have in his or her possession any alcoholic liquor, except when such minor is in a private residence accompanied by his or her parent or guardian, and with such parent's or guardian's consent.

(b) For the purposes of this section, possession of alcoholic liquor includes the acceptance or consumption of a bottle of such liquor, or any portion thereof or a drink of such liquor. However, this section does not prohibit the acceptance or consumption by any person of sacramental wine as part of a religious rite or service.

Section 2. The council desires and deems it necessary for the preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Willamina, that this ordinance take effect at once, and therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval:
