ORDINANCE NO. 682

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 93.07 OF THE WILLAMINA CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the City of Willamina Code of Ordinances provides the parameters by which the City of Willamina shall operate; and

WHEREAS, the Willamina Development Code contains code sections providing that no RVs, trailers, boats or other similar vehicles shall be parked in the front yard of a dwelling; and

WHEREAS, the Willamina Development Code also contains a code section which provides that parking in front yards or yards adjacent to streets are not allowed; and

WHEREAS, the Willamina Development Code sections are enforced through planning, but post-planning there is no parallel code or ordinance to enforce these requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Willamina City Council desires to rectify this situation by creating a parallel code within the Willamina Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILLAMINA ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Revisions

Section 93.07(B) of the Willamina Code of Ordinances shall be revised as follows:

(12) Parking. Other than in legally permitted and improved driveways or legally permitted and improved paved areas, no automobile, truck, trailer, boat, motorcycle, or other vehicle shall be parked, placed, or left in the front yard or yard areas that are adjacent to a street of a residential dwelling, commercial or other structure.

Section 2: Severability:

The sections, subsections, paragraphs and clauses of this Ordinance are severable. The invalidity of one section, subsection, paragraph, or clause shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, paragraphs, or clauses.

Section 3: Codification:

Provisions of this Ordinance shall be incorporated into the City Code and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "code", "article", "section", "chapter", or other word, and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered, or re-lettered, provided however that any "Whereas" clauses and boilerplate provisions (i.e. Section 2) need not be codified and the City Recorder is authorized to correct any cross-references and any typographical errors.

Section 4: Effective Date:

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after adoption

The foregoing Ordinance No. 682 was first read into the record in full and then by title and passed by a unanimous vote of all council members in attendance in accordance with Chapter VIII, Section 30-31 of the City Charter on the 13th day of October, 2020.
