## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 20-21-002**

A Resolution of the Willamina City Council extending the term of Office for the Library Board members and waiving the requirement that no person shall hold office for more than two consecutive terms.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Willamina is currently under an Emergency Declaration due to the COVID19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the terms of a number of the Library Board members are ending; and

WHEREAS, due to the COVID19 pandemic, the direct recruitment of Library patrons---the historically most effective recruitment method---is unavailable; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a significant concern that those community members within the vulnerable population or who have been economically adversely affected by the COVID19 pandemic would be unable to serve at this time.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLAMINA THAT:

The requirement that no person shall hold office for more than two consecutive terms shall be waived, and that the term of office of the members of the current sitting Library Board which otherwise would expire, shall be extended until 180 days after the current Emergency Declaration is revoked.
