WHEREAS, the City of Willamina City Council declared a State of Emergency due to the Coronavirus Pandemic through Resolution Number 19-20-003; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willamina City Council extended that State of Emergency until it is affirmatively revoked through Resolution 19-20-004; and

WHEREAS, a vaccine has been developed and implemented that aids in the protection against Coronavirus infection; and

WHEREAS, as of June 30, 2021, the Governor's Executive Orders regarding closures, slow-downs, mask protocols, and distancing protocols were revoked due to the significant reduction of the spread of the Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, there is no longer a need for a state of emergency as a result of the Coronavirus pandemic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLAMINA THAT:

Section 1: Resolution 19-20-003 and Resolution 19-20-004 shall be revoked; and

Section 2: The state of emergency declared by those Resolutions is revoked; and

Section 3: All City operations shall return to normal.
