

ORDINANCE NO. 555

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 550, SECTIONS 5, 6, AND 7 PRESCRIBING THE METHODS AND PROCEDURES FOR MAKING ASSESSMENTS ON CITY OF WILLAMINA ECONOMIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AFFECTED PROPERTY, AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF SAID ASSESSMENTS, DESIGNATING A TERM OF OFFICE OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE ECONOMIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WILLAMINA, OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 550 passed by the Council December 27, 1990 and approved by the Mayor December 28, 1990 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. The assessments authorized under this Ordinance are hereby directed to be entered in the docket of city liens effective January 1, 1991. Beginning July 15, 1991 and each year thereafter, the City Recorder shall secure the assessed value of each property to be assessed and shall forward a listing of each property and the prescribed rate to be levied to the County Assessor of the County in which the property is located, who shall cause the prescribed rate to be levied.

Section 2. Section 6, paragraph 1 of Ordinance No. 550 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6. The City Recorder shall disburse funds to the Economic Improvement District as they are received, beginning February 1, 1991 and for the duration of the district, to accomplish the purposes set forth in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 550. No funds shall be distributed if the Economic Improvement District ceases to exist or the purposes set forth in the by-laws of the organization are amended so as to be in conflict with the enabling legislation contained in ORS Chapter 223 or in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 550.

Section 3. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 550 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7. An advisory committee for the Economic Improvement District shall be created by the City Council upon passage of this ordinance. The advisory committee shall consist of five individuals who are either owners of property or managers of businesses located within the Economic

Improvement District. The committee members shall serve a one year term. The City Council shall receive nominees for members of the advisory committee and shall give due consideration to the nominees presented to the Council by local business organizations. The advisory committee shall have the responsibility to allocate expenditures of monies for economic improvement activities within the scope of this ordinance.

Section 4. The Council desires and deems it necessary for the preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Willamina that this ordinance take effect at once, and therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
