

ORDINANCE NO. 558

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PARTICIPATION BY THE CITY OF WILLAMINA IN AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT RE-CHARTERING THE MID-WILLAMETTE VALLEY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Willamina has been a member of the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments (MWVOG); and

WHEREAS, the member governments to MWVCOG desire to revise and reform the Charter and Agreement by which the MWVCOG is created; and

WHEREAS ORS 190.085 requires that prior to the effective date of an intergovernmental agreement creating an intergovernmental entity, each of the parties to the agreement shall enact an ordinance ratifying the creation of the intergovernmental entity;

The City of Willamina, Oregon, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.

It is the intent of the City Council of the City of Willamina to create, along with the other parties to the agreement, an intergovernmental entity known as the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments.

SECTION 2.

The effective date, specification of public purposes for which the MWVCOG is created, and the powers, duties and functions of the MWVCOG are as stated in the Agreement attached hereto and, by this reference, incorporated herein.

SECTION 3.

The said Agreement is hereby ratified and the Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to sign the same on behalf of the City of Willamina.

SECTION 4.

The Council desires and deems it necessary for the preservation of the health, peace, safety and general welfare of the City of Willamina that this ordinance take effect at once, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
