

ORDINANCE NO. 596

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WILLAMINA COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, ORDINANCE NO. 540, BY UPDATING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PUBLIC FACILITIES, SAFETY and SERVICES ELEMENTS, and REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, on March 2, 1999, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing to consider action to amend the Public Facilities and Public Safety and Services Elements of the Comprehensive Plan, and subsequently recommended to the City Council the adoption of these; and

WHEREAS, on April 8, 1999, the City Council of the City of Willamina conducted a public hearing to consider action to amend the Public Facilities and Public Safety and Services Elements of the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, Task Nos. 7 & 8 of the Periodic Review Work Program requires the City to revise and update its Comprehensive Plan relating to Public Facilities and Public Safety and Services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, The City of Willamina, Oregon ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Public Facilities and Public Safety and Services Elements of Comprehensive Plan. City Ordinance No. 540 is hereby amended by adopting an updated Comprehensive Plan Public Facilities, Safety and Services element, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference made part of, is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. Conflicting Ordinance. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Emergency Clause. The City Council declares that an emergency exists affecting the health, safety and welfare of the public, and that, therefore, this ordinance shall be put into effect immediately upon the passage and adoption by the City Council.
