



NOTICE OF CALL FOR BIDS FOR PRICE PER MILE
FOR PULVERIZING/GRADING/PACKING IN WILLIAMS COUNTY

The Board of County Commissioners of Williams County, North Dakota will receive sealed bids at the office of the County Auditor, PO Box 2047, Williston, ND 58802-2047, up until **March 12, 2025, at 11:00am (CST)** for price per mile pulverizing/grading/ packing in Williams County. Please mark on the sealed envelope “pulverizing/grading/ packing in Williams County”

Stabilization Guideline:

Based on 32 feed wide – 4 passes with 1 foot overlap with total treated 28’ road top

- Step 1: Pulverizer shall be a self-propelled machine designed to pulverize the existing earth in layers to a depth of 8”. The machine shall be capable of incorporating water and stabilization chemical (chemical provided by Williams County) product into the mixture with uniform moisture content. The mixing rate shall not exceed 70’ per minimum.
- Step 2: Compaction will follow immediately behind the pulverizer steel drum/grading then pneumatic.
- Step 3: All rocks on the road top larger than 8” shall be picked up and hauled to a location chosen by Williams County within 3 miles of working mile.

Road Reclaimer/Rock Pulverizer with water injection/Steel Drum Packer/Motor Grader/
Pneumatic Roller/Water Truck Hauling/Water Depot (max 20 mile loaded haul)/Traffic Control
must follow (MUTCD)/Mobilization is all incidental to bid per mile.
