WHEREAS, The North Dakota State Department of Health, upon receipt of a petition from the City Commission of Williston, North Dakota, requesting the establishment of a vector control district comprised of the hereinafter described area, made studies and investigations as required and outlined in Chapter 23-24 of the North Dakota Century Code, and

WHEREAS, Public hearings were duly advertised and held pursuant to Chapter 23-24 of the North Dakota Century Code and the testimony of freeholders within the proposed vector control district #1 was taken, and

WHEREAS, The North Dakota State Health Council, at a regular meeting held December 16, 1966, considered the report on the investigation conducted by the State Health Officer as to the feasibility, desirability, necessity or practical pertaining to the establishment of the proposed district,

NOW THEREFORE, The North Dakota State Health Council does herein unanimously issue the following order:

ORDER

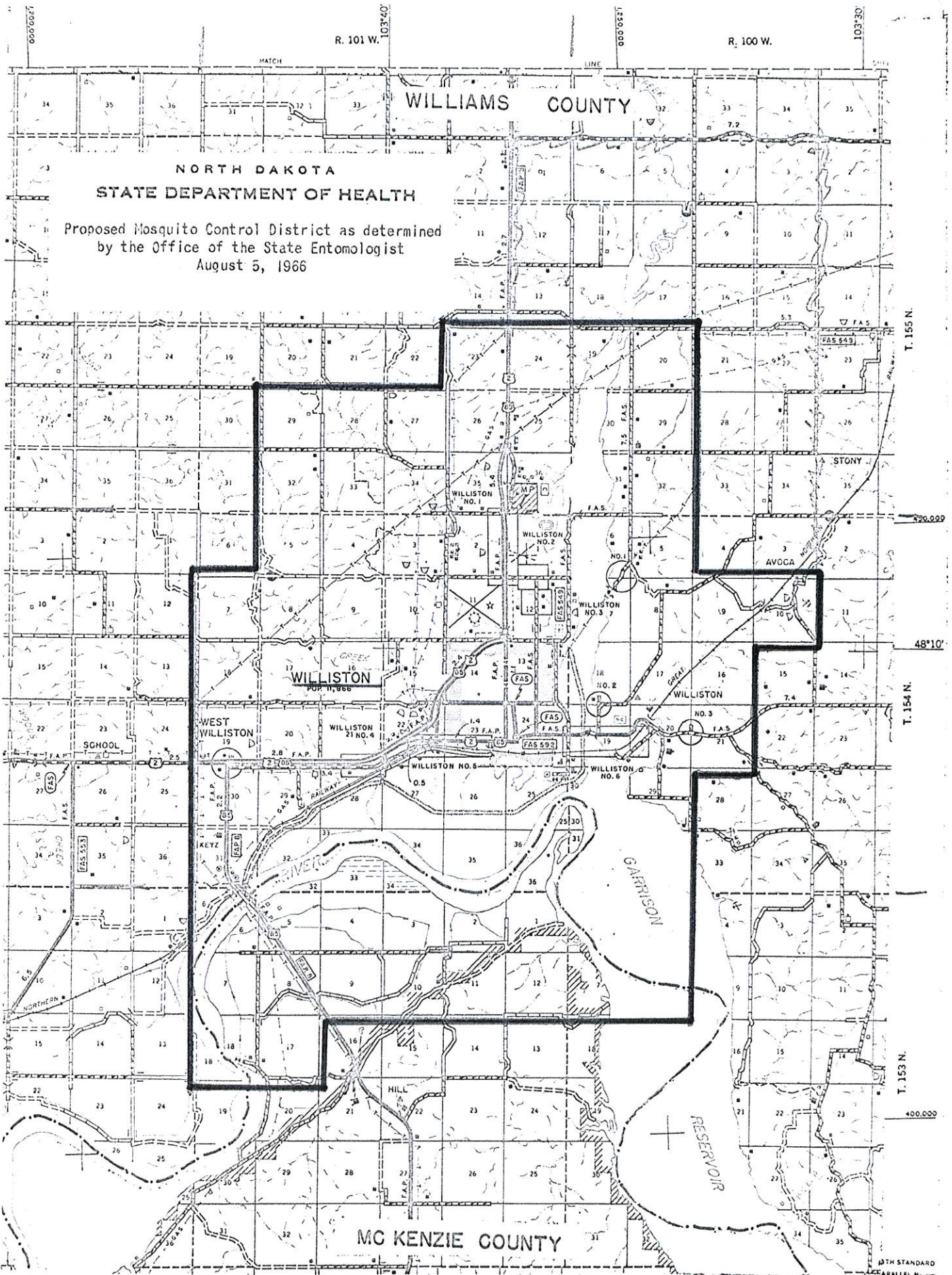

ORDER EXPANDING VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT NO. 1 IN WILLIAMS COUNTY
AND ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT
NO. 1 AND VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT NO. 2 IN WILLIAMS COUNTY

WHEREAS, the North Dakota State Department of Health, upon receipt of a petition from Vector Control District No. 1 requesting the expansion of Vector Control District No. 1 to include all parts of Williams County except for those parts of Williams County that are included in Vector Control District No. 2, pursuant to N.D.C.C. ch. 23-24, and

WHEREAS, an investigation and public hearing were completed pursuant to the legal requirements of chapter 23-24, including testimony and comments from residents of Williams County who would be affected by the change, and

WHEREAS, the North Dakota State Health Council, at its meeting on March 19, 2015, considered all of the above and the legal requirements to expand Vector Control District No. 1 under N.D.C.C. ch. 23-24, and

WHEREAS, Vector Control District No. 2 included the political subdivision of Westbank Township, Tioga Township, and Pleasant Valley Township in Williams County. Tioga Township and Pleasant Valley Township were withdrawn from Vector Control District No. 2 in 1990 and Westbank Township was withdrawn from Vector Control District No. 2 in 1993. This left the city of Tioga, North Dakota, as its boundaries may exist from time-to-time, as the only portion of Williams County presently contained within Vector Control District No. 2.

NOW THEREFORE, the North Dakota State Health Council does herein issue the following Order:

ORDER

That all portions of Williams County that are not contained in Vector Control District No. 2 are added to Vector Control District No. 1, and

That the only remaining area of Vector Control District No. 2 in Williams County, North Dakota, is that land located within the boundaries of the city of Tioga, as the city boundaries may from time-to-time exist, and


That if the city of Tioga annexes additional land within Williams County, North Dakota, that land shall be deemed withdrawn from Vector Control District No. 1, and added to Vector Control District No. 2.


