Upcoming Holidays

No Delays or Closings for Veterans Day

There will be no service delays for the Veterans Day holiday.

All Granger offices and facilities will be OPEN for normal business hours the week of November 11, 2024.

Delay for Some Customers for Thanksgiving Day

Only customers with Thursday or Friday service will see delays due to the Thanksgiving holiday.

Friday service: Delayed to Saturday

Yard Waste



As residents are cleaning up their yards before we transition into winter, we thought it would be helpful to go over a few yard waste FAQs.

What is yard waste?

Yard waste includes items like leaves, grass clippings, vegetable or other garden debris, shrubbery or brush or tree trimmings, less than 4 feet in length and 2 inches in diameter.

Can I throw my yard waste in the trash?

Although many people don't realize it, it's actually against the law to put yard waste in a landfill in Michigan, so it should not be put out as trash. Other options include separate yard waste collection and backyard composting. Please visit the [Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy website](#) for more information.

When does yard waste collection end for the season?

The last yard waste collection day for the 2024 season is November 30 (delayed by one day due to the Thanksgiving holiday).

Where can residents dispose of yard waste if they don't have yard waste collection or when collection is done for the season?
